John Deere Road work in Moline begins April 17

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that weather permitting, construction on John Deere Road (Illinois 5) in Moline will begin Monday, April 17. The work zone will be between 16th and 35th streets.

Work includes pavement patching and resurfacing John Deere Road from 16th Street to 35th Street, and expansion joint replacement, deck patching, and resurfacing of the structures carrying John Deere Road over 27th Street and Interstate 74. Pavement patching is anticipated to take two weeks to complete and will utilize nightly lane closures from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., with a single lane closure during the day. The entire \$7 million project is expected to be completed by the end of October.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements
