I-290 ramp to Biesterfield Road project resumes

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a project to improve the exit ramp from northbound Interstate 290 to Biesterfield Road (Illinois 53), in Elk Grove Village, resumes, weather permitting, Monday, April 3. To complete the work daytime and occasional overnight lane closures will take place.

The \$1.7 million project involves reconstructing and widening the existing exit ramp, adding an additional dedicated right turn lane, installing new modernized traffic signals and resurfacing.

At least one lane will remain open throughout construction, anticipated to be completed later this summer.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements.
