U.S. 40 bridge repairs begin March 13

GREENVILLE – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that bridge repairs on U.S. 40, between Greenville and Mulberry Grove in Bond County, will require one lane to be closed beginning, weather permitting, Monday, March 13. Two-way traffic will be maintained by traffic signals.

This stage of the project will last until June and is one of several restrictions throughout the life of the work, which includes bridge repairs, pavement patching and resurfacing. The times and locations of the future restrictions will be announced as the project continues. The improvements are expected to be completed by the end of the 2023 construction season.

Drivers are urged to reduce speed, be alert for changing conditions, obey all construction signage, consider alternate routes, and refrain from using mobile devices while approaching and traveling through the work zone.
