Eastbound McClugage traffic change begins May 3

EAST PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that as part of the ongoing work on the new eastbound McClugage Bridge (U.S. 150), there will be change to the traffic pattern on the East Peoria side of the bridge beginning May 3.

The new pattern will turn the right lane of eastbound U.S. 150 into an exit-only lane to southbound Main Street (Illinois 116). Motorists wanting to continue on either eastbound U.S. 24 or northbound Illinois 116 will use the left lane. This traffic pattern is expected to be in place until early June. There will be no changes to the current traffic pattern on the Peoria side of the McClugage Bridge.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements.
