Illinois 26 bridge repairs in Stephenson County begin May 8

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that bridge repairs on Illinois 26 in Stephenson County will begin Monday, May 8. The work zone is located 2.5 miles north of Cedarville.

The work will close a lane on the bridge starting at 8 a.m. on May 8. Traffic will be reduced to one lane with a barrier wall and controlled by traffic signals in the work zone. The work is scheduled to be completed by noon on Friday, May 12.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements.
