I-74 Lane Closures near Morton

PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces the following lane closures:

- The right lane of westbound I-74 will be closed between I-474 and Morton Avenue from 5:30 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 22 to 6 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 23.
 - The lane closure is necessary to restripe pavement markings and relocate temporary concrete barrier to move westbound I-74 traffic onto the recently constructed I-74 pavement under I-155.

- The left lane of eastbound I-74 will be closed between I-474 and Morton Avenue from 5:30 p.m. Sept. 23 to 6 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 24 and from 5:30 p.m. Friday, Sept. 25 through Saturday, Sept. 26.
 - The lane closure is necessary to restripe pavement markings and relocate temporary concrete barrier to move eastbound I-74 traffic onto the recently constructed I-74 pavement under I-155.

Significant travel delays are possible for I-74 motorists during this time.

The overall project is the complete reconstruction of I-74 from Pleasant Hill Road to Morton Avenue in Tazewell County.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
