SUBJECT: BDE Manual Revision - Chapter 17

DATE: March 4, 2011

Chapter 17 of the BDE Manual has been revised to reflect the current procedures for the coordinating bicycle/pedestrian accommodations, exceptions, and omissions. See Chapter 17 of the BDE Manual on-line to view the revisions.

Background

Sections 17-1.03, 17-2.01, and 17-4.05 — Since the adoption of Complete Streets, the involvement of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Coordinator in BDE at the project level has evolved. To reflect the current practice, the coordination procedures and documentation requirements for projects with bicycle/pedestrian accommodations, or projects with exceptions/omissions of such accommodations, have been revised.

Sections 17-2.02(e) and 17-2.03(j) – Previously any type of structure project would require accommodations. These revisions allow more latitude for bridge deck only projects and define culverts as not being structures for the purpose of accommodation warrants.
