**PEORIA** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces the construction of a portion of the bridge carrying I-74 over US 150 (Jackson Street) in Morton will begin this weekend.

The left lanes of eastbound and westbound I-74 between I-155 and Morton Avenue in Morton will be closed from 5:30 p.m. Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup> to 6:00 a.m. Monday, May 19<sup>th</sup>.

The work will consist of bridge beam setting over Jackson Street and will require intermittent 20 minute closures of Jackson Street starting at 8:30 p.m. Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup>.

The overall project is the complete reconstruction of I-74 from Pleasant Hill Road to Morton Avenue in Tazewell County.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
