COUNTY ENGINEERS/SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

The unused FY 2007 funds will lapse two years from the date of this letter. The two-year obligation period also applies to currently unused FY 2006 funds. Consequently, the FY 2006 funds will lapse on August 8, 2007.

Please submit your FY 2007 Township Bridge Program to your district office by September 15, 2006. Utilize form BLR 09210 for your submittals and provide all information as indicated. If participation in preliminary engineering is desired, it should be included as a separate project.
