CIRCULAR LETTER 2010-08

TOWNSHIP BRIDGE PROGRAM

COUNTY ENGINEERS/SUPERINTENDENTS OF HIGHWAYS

Attached is a list of counties with their FY 2011 Township Bridge Program (TBP) allotments of the \$15 million as authorized by the General Assembly to be used by the road districts for construction of bridges.

Due to new legislation (House Bill 641/Public Act 96-0366) effective January 1, 2010, the lapse period for TBP fund expenditures has now been extended from two years to four years.

Therefore, any unused FY 2011 TBP funds will lapse four years from the date of this letter (August 19, 2014). The FY 2010 TBP funds will lapse on August 24, 2013. The FY 2009 TBP funds will lapse on August 11, 2012.

Please submit your FY 2011 Township Bridge Program to your district office by September 17, 2010 or as directed by your district. Utilize form BLR 09210 for your submittals and provide all information as indicated. If participation in preliminary engineering is desired, it should be included as a separate project.
