TOWNSHIP BRIDGE PROGRAM

COUNTY ENGINEERS/SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

Attached is a list of counties with their FY 2013 Township Bridge Program (TBP) allotments of the \$15 million as authorized by the General Assembly to be used by the road districts for construction of bridges.

Any unused FY 2013 TBP funds will lapse four years from the date of this Circular Letter 2012-14 (July 27, 2012). Unused FY 2012 TBP funds will lapse on September 8, 2015. The FY 2011 funds will lapse on August 19, 2014. FY 2010 TBP funds will lapse on August 24, 2013. [The FY 2009 TBP funds will lapse on August 11, 2012].

Please submit your FY 2013 Township Bridge Program to your district office by October 5, 2012 or as directed by your district. Utilize form BLR 09210 for your submittals and provide all information as indicated. If participation in preliminary engineering is desired, it should be included as a separate project.
