TOWNSHIP BRIDGE PROGRAM

COUNTY ENGINEERS / SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

Attached is a list of counties with their FY 2018 Township Bridge Program (TBP) allotment of the \$15 million, as authorized by the General Assembly, to be used by the road districts for the construction of bridges.

Any unused FY 2018 TBP funds will lapse four years from the date of Circular Letter 2017-21 (August 30, 2021). Unused FY 2017 TBP funds will lapse on August 25, 2020. Unused FY 2016 TBP funds will lapse on September 21, 2019. Unused FY 2015 TBP funds will lapse on August 21, 2018. The FY 2014 funds lapsed on August 5, 2017.

Please submit your FY 2018 Township Bridge Program to your district office by September 29, 2017 or as directed by your district. Utilize form BLR 09210 for your submittals and provide all information as indicated. If participation in preliminary engineering is desired, it should be included as a separate project.
