

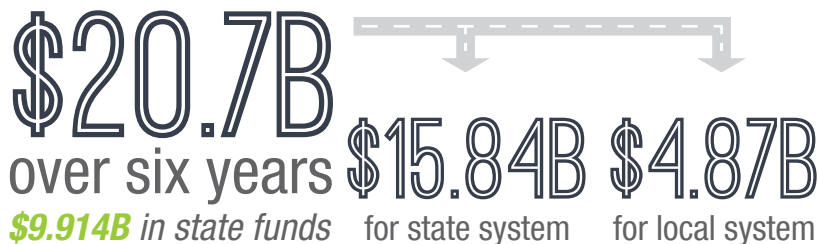

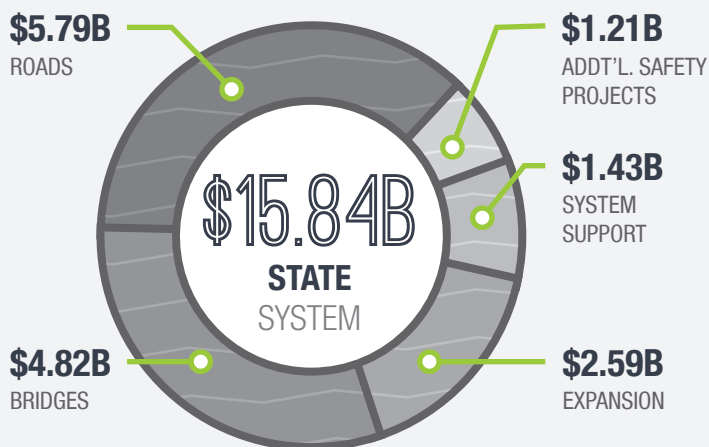
REBUILDING OUR MYP

IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON MOTOR FUEL TAX REVENUES



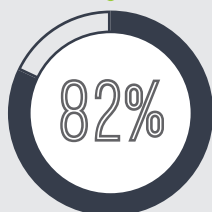
Due to the pandemic, **vehicle miles traveled in Illinois dropped by 13%** in 2020.

The decrease in motor fuel tax revenues was largely offset by federal COVID-19 relief, **preserving projects in the MYP.**

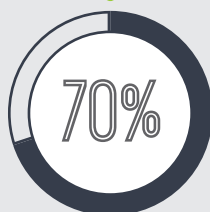

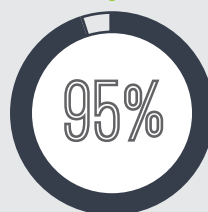

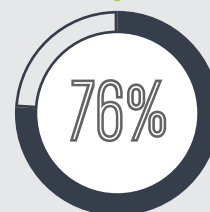


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

COOK

- **I-190 from Bessie Coleman Drive to I-90 (Kennedy Expressway):** \$516 million for reconstruction, addition of auxiliary lanes and other capacity enhancements from Bessie Coleman Drive to I-90, improving safety and access to O'Hare International Airport.
- **U.S. 12/20/45:** \$107.6 million total investment.
 - ☐ **\$81.7 million** for bridge replacement, railroad separation replacement and other improvements at Stony Island Avenue in Chicago.
 - ☐ **\$25.9 million** for new bridge decks, bridge repairs and other improvements at Santa Fe Drive, Sanitary and Shipping Canal, I&M Canal and ICG Railroad in Willow Springs.
- **Illinois 43:** \$105 million to construct railroad grade separation at 65th Street and Harlem Avenue in Bedford Park.
- **I-290:** \$48.3 million total investment for bridge replacements and other improvements.
 - ☐ **\$22.8 million** at Ogden Avenue.
 - ☐ **\$13.7 million** at Ashland Avenue.
 - ☐ **\$11.8 million** at Leavitt Street.
- **Pershing Road:** \$45.9 million for bridge replacement and other improvements at Racine Avenue and CN Railroad.
- **I-55:** \$41.1 million for bridge replacement and other improvements at Illinois 43 in Forest View.
- **I-80:** \$27.6 million for bridge replacement and other improvements at I-294 in Hazel Crest.
- **Willow Road:** \$22 million for reconstruction, intersection improvements and construction of additional lanes from east of Des Plaines River to Waterview Drive.

DUPAGE

- **Illinois 56 corridor improvements:** \$27.5 million for a new bridge, reconstruction and construction of additional lanes from west of Illinois 53 to west of Veterans Memorial Tollway, and other improvements at Illinois 53.
- **Illinois 38:** \$23.3 million for widening and resurfacing of Illinois 38 from Winfield Road to County Line Road and intersection improvements at Winfield and County Line Road in Wheaton/Winfield.
- **I-55:** \$4 million for a bridge replacement at Clarendon Hills Road and I-55.

KANE

- **U.S. 20:** \$94.4 million for bridge replacements, construction of auxiliary lanes and other improvements from west of Randall Road to east of Shales Parkway.
- **Illinois 47/U.S. 30:** \$65.5 million to improve 4.3 miles with bridge replacements, reconstruction and additional lanes, as well as other improvements from Cross Street to south of Galena Boulevard.

LAKE

- **Illinois 60/Illinois 83:** \$112.3 million for reconstruction and additional lanes, as well as construction of a railroad grade separation from Illinois 176 (Maple Avenue) to CN Railroad.
- **U.S. 41 at Illinois 176 in Lake Bluff and North Chicago:** \$51.6 million for interchange reconstruction and construction of auxiliary lanes and drainage improvements.
- **Illinois 131:** \$51.5 million to improve 2.5 miles with reconstruction and additional lanes from Wadsworth Road to Sunset Avenue.
- **Illinois 120:** \$29.4 million for reconstruction and additional lanes from Ashford Lane to U.S. 45.

MCHENRY

- **Illinois 31:** \$97 million for reconstruction, widening and additional lanes for 6.3 miles from Illinois 120 to north of Illinois 176, drainage improvements, traffic signal modernization, ADA improvements and culvert replacement at a drainage ditch 4 miles south of U.S. 12.
- **Illinois 47:** \$88 million total investment.
 - ☐ **\$48 million** for reconstruction and additional lanes, as well as intersection improvements, from north of Illinois 120 to U.S. 14 in Woodstock.
 - ☐ **\$40 million** for intersection reconstruction at Illinois 176 (north and south junctions) and at Pleasant Valley Road.

WILL

- **I-80 from Ridge Road to U.S. 30:** Total \$1.1 billion investment to rebuild critical freight corridor and improve safety in high-growth area. Multiple bridge replacements, including aging, obsolete structures over the Des Plaines River. Capacity enhancements include auxiliary lanes and shoulders.
- **I-55:** \$181.4 million for bridge replacements and construction of interchanges at Airport Road/Lockport Road and at Illinois 126.
- **I-55:** \$144.3 million for interchange reconstruction, bridge replacements, reconstruction and widening of 2.5 miles from Illinois 129 to Lorenzo Road, reconstruction of the frontage roads between Kavanaugh and Lorenzo Roads.
- **U.S. 52:** \$92.2 million for reconstruction and widening of the roadway and bridge widening from River Road to Houbolt Road in Joliet and Shorewood.
- **Illinois 53:** \$47 million for intersection improvements.
