

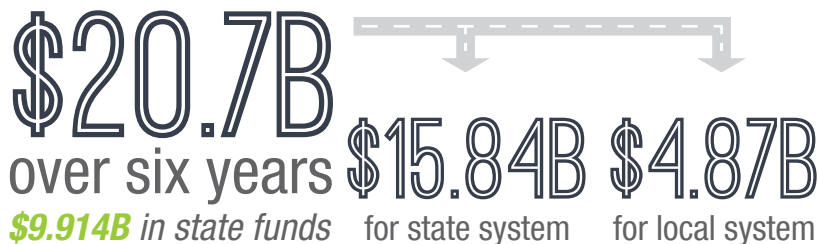

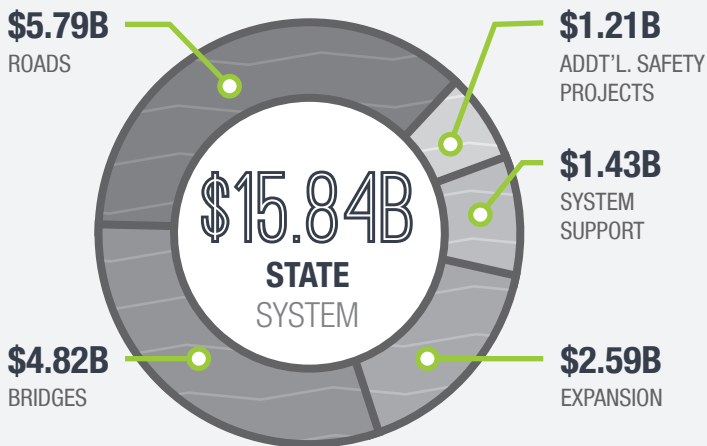
## REBUILDING OUR MYP

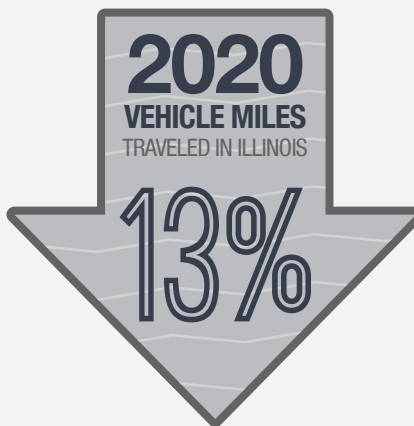

### IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON MOTOR FUEL TAX REVENUES



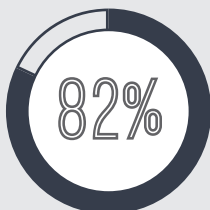
Due to the pandemic, **vehicle miles traveled in Illinois dropped by 13%** in 2020.

The decrease in motor fuel tax revenues was largely offset by federal COVID-19 relief, **preserving projects in the MYP.**

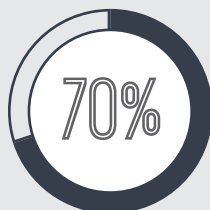

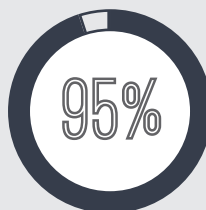

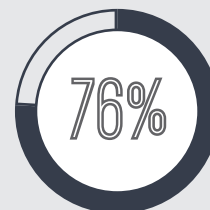


### STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

### MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

#### BUREAU

- **I-80:** \$21 million for resurfacing 9.5 miles, a bridge deck overlay and bridge repairs from Henry County line to Illinois 40.

#### DEKALB

- **Illinois 38:** \$8.7 million for resurfacing 9.8 miles and ADA improvements from John Huber Parkway (South) to Kane County line.

#### IROQUOIS

- **I-57:** \$67.5 million for resurfacing 22 miles, bridge repairs, bridge deck overlay and additional improvements from Ford County line to U.S. 24.

#### KANKAKEE

- **I-57:** \$48.8 million for resurfacing 4.4 miles, bridge repairs, bridge deck overlay, bridge replacement and other improvements from Clifton to Kankakee County line, plus the U.S. 45/52 interchange in Kankakee.
- **Manteno Interchange:** \$28.5 million to reconstruct the I-57/Manteno Interchange, bridge replacement, retaining wall and other improvements north of Kankakee.

#### KENDALL

- **Illinois 47:** \$57.8 million for reconstruction and additional lanes of 2.3 miles, railroad separation replacement, bridge replacement and other improvements between Galena and Kennedy roads.
- **Illinois 47:** \$43 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 4.2 miles, as well as additional improvements, from Illinois 71 to Caton Farm Road.
- **Illinois 71:** \$40 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 3.7 miles, bridge replacement and other improvements from east of Illinois 126 to west of Orchard Road.
