

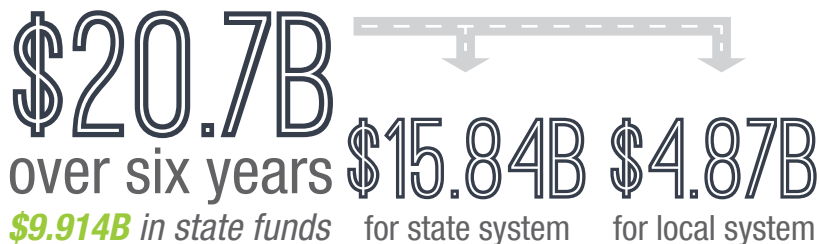

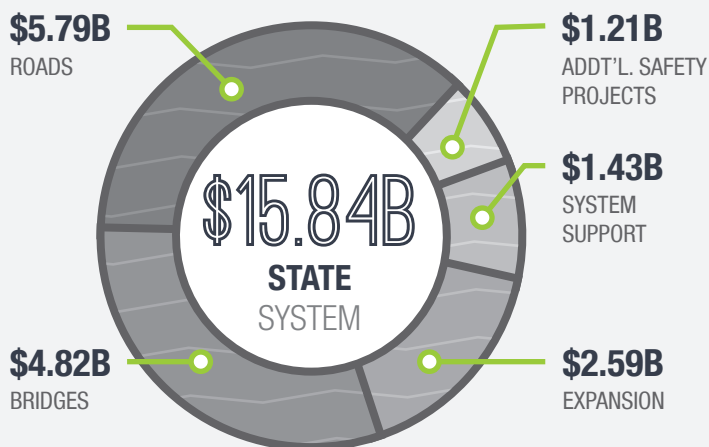
REBUILDING OUR MYP

IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON MOTOR FUEL TAX REVENUES



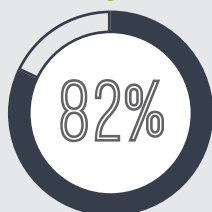
Due to the pandemic, **vehicle miles traveled in Illinois dropped by 13%** in 2020.

The decrease in motor fuel tax revenues was largely offset by federal COVID-19 relief, **preserving projects in the MYP.**

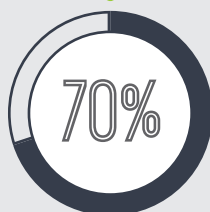

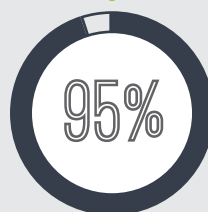


NON-INTERSTATES

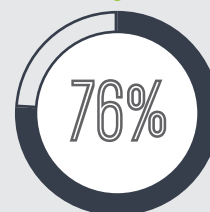


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

FULTON, KNOX & MCDONOUGH

- **Illinois 41:** \$24.8 million for resurfacing of 11.7 miles and utility adjustments from Illinois 116 to Illinois 9.

FULTON & PEORIA

- **U.S. 24/Illinois 9:** \$111 million to expand to four lanes and bridge replacements from Banner to Kingston Mines.

MARSHALL

- **Illinois 18:** \$128 million for a bridge replacement over the Illinois River at Henry.

PEORIA

- **Illinois 29:** \$65.5 million for resurfacing and addition of middle turn lane along 2.9 miles of North Galena Road from Gardner Lane to the McClugage Bridge.
- **Cedar Street Extension:** \$49.5 million for interchange reconstruction and bridge replacement on Illinois 8/116 over the Tazewell & Peoria Railroad and Illinois 29 in East Peoria.
- **Adams Street:** \$29 million for bridge replacements, railroad flagger and other improvements over BNSF and UP railroad at western corporate limits of Peoria.
- **Interstate 474/U.S. 24:** \$24.4 million for resurfacing along 14.2 miles (including ramp repair) and bridge repairs from I-74 to the Illinois River.

WARREN

- **U.S. 67:** \$23.5 million for resurfacing of 6.9 miles, widening existing pavement, new shoulders and culvert replacement from 270th Avenue/County Highway 3 to U.S. 34 at Monmouth.

WOODFORD

- **Interstate 74:** \$16.5 million for a bridge replacement over the Mackinaw River.

WOODFORD & MARSHALL

- **Interstate 39:** \$27.3 million for resurfacing of 10.9 miles from Illinois 116 to Illinois 17.
