

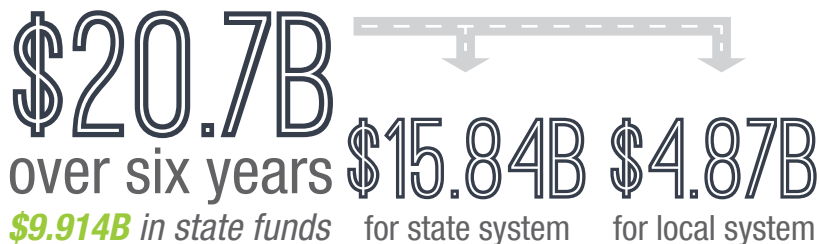

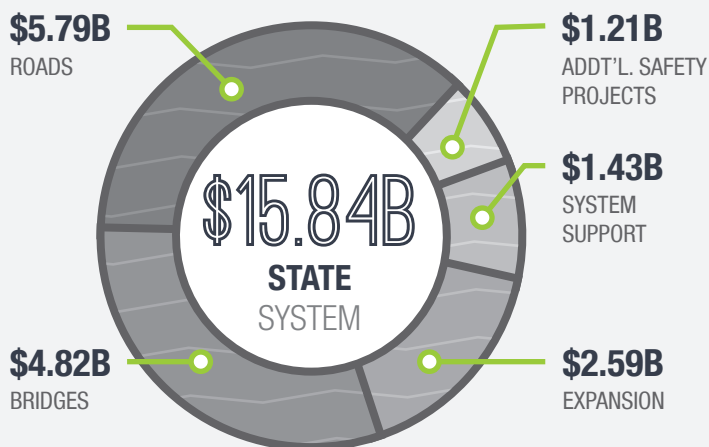
REBUILDING OUR MYP

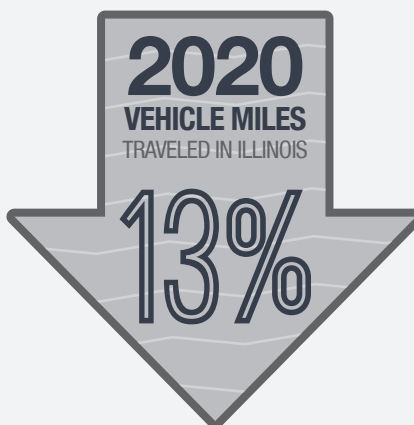

IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON MOTOR FUEL TAX REVENUES



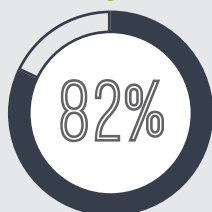
Due to the pandemic, **vehicle miles traveled in Illinois dropped by 13%** in 2020.

The decrease in motor fuel tax revenues was largely offset by federal COVID-19 relief, **preserving projects in the MYP.**

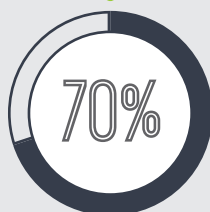

INTERSTATES

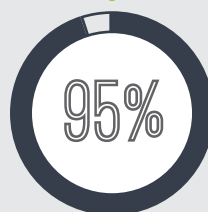


NON-INTERSTATES

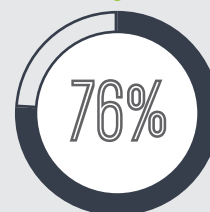


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

CASS

- **Beardstown bridge:** \$67 million for new U.S. 67/ Illinois 100 bridge over the Illinois River. The new structure will replace one that has been subject to weight restrictions in the past due to its condition.

MACOUPIN

- **Illinois 16:** \$19 million for resurfacing of 10.2 miles, new culverts, bridge replacements, ADA improvements and other improvements from Jersey County line to Illinois 159.

MONTGOMERY

- **I-55:** \$37.2 million for reconstruction of 2.3 miles, including ramp repair, and resurfacing of 5.2 miles from Illinois 48/127 to Mine Avenue.

PIKE

- **Florence Bridge:** \$80.6 million for new Illinois 100/106 bridge over the Illinois River, replacing structurally deficient, functionally obsolete structure built in 1929.

SANGAMON

- **I-55:** \$134.1 million for additional lanes and reconstruction along 7.8 miles (including ramp repair), bridge replacement, bridge widening and other improvements from Illinois 54/Sangamon Avenue to 2.7 miles south of Illinois 123.
- **Illinois 97/125:** \$86.5 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 6.5 miles, bridge replacement, intersection reconstruction, bridge removal/demolition, pedestrian overpass and other improvements from Illinois 97/125 junction to Illinois 4.
- **I-55:** \$62.1 million for resurfacing of 5.4 miles (including ramp repair), reconstruction of 6.2 miles (including ramp repair), bridge deck overlay and bridge repairs from the Sangamon/Montgomery County line to Horse Farm Road.
- **I-55 Business/Sixth Street:** \$41.1 million for reconstruction and additional lanes on 3.9 miles, turning lanes, sidewalks and other improvements from I-72 to north of Stanford Avenue.
