Illinois Highway, Aviation, Rail, Transit and Marine Systems

- **Population** – 12.74 million
- **Licensed drivers** – 9.19 million
- **Total vehicle registrations** – 11.70 million
- **Annual vehicle miles of travel** – 108 billion
- **Annual gallons of fuel consumed** – 6.4 billion
- **Miles of road** – 147,028 centerline miles throughout the state
- **Miles under state jurisdiction** – 15,911
- **Miles plowed by snow removal crews** – 45,604
- **Bridges** – 7,856 bridges under state jurisdiction
- **Rest areas** – 30
- **Seat belt usage** – 94.6% for front-seat occupants in 2018
- **Annual traffic deaths** – 1,031 (provisional) in 2018
- **Public-use aviation landing facilities** – 107
- **Registered aircraft** – 8,303
- **Registered pilots** – 15,061
- **Railroad grade crossings** – 10,262, with 7,595 public crossings and 3,589 private crossings, the second-highest total in the United States
- **Amtrak annual ridership** – 4.6 million riders at Illinois stations
- **Transit systems** – 58 throughout the state, operating in 96 of the 102 counties
- **Transit passenger trips** – 621 million annually
- **Inland navigable waterways** – Mississippi, Ohio, Kaskaskia and Illinois rivers, including the Chicago Area Waterway System
- **Miles of navigable waterways** – 1,118
- **River locks** – 28
- **Marine terminals** – Approximately 350
