

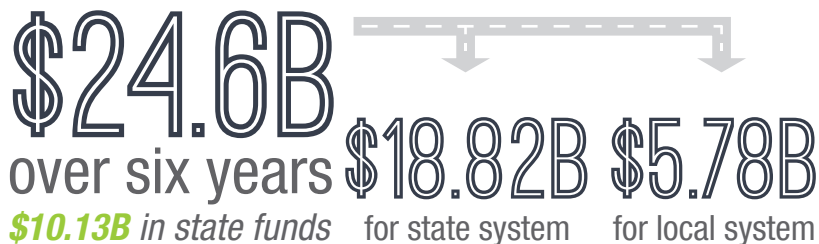

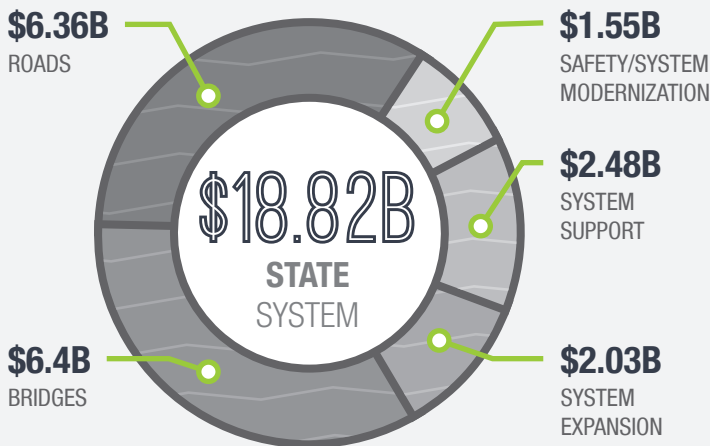
REBUILDING OUR MYP

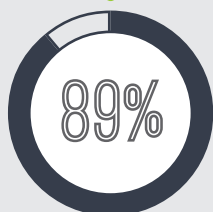

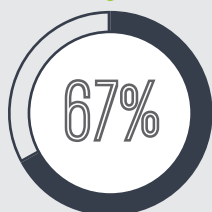

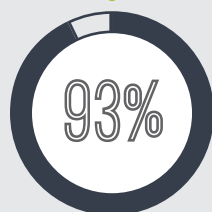

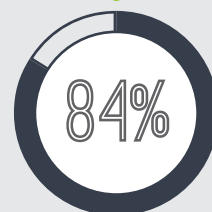


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

COOK

- **I-190 from Bessie Coleman Drive to I-90 (Kennedy Expressway):** \$518 million for reconstruction and construction of auxiliary lanes, construction of auxiliary lanes and additional ramps from Bessie Coleman Drive to I-90, improving safety and access to O'Hare International Airport in Chicago and Rosemont.
- **Illinois 53:** \$110.7 million for twelve new bridge decks, three bridge superstructure replacements and other improvements from U.S. 12 to Illinois 62 in Arlington Heights, Palatine and Rolling Meadows.
- **I-90/94:** \$105.9 million for bridge deck overlays, bridge joint replacements and repairs, bridge approach roadwork, patching and other improvements from I-94 to Hubbard Street in Chicago.
- **Illinois 43:** \$91.3 million to construct railroad grade separation at 65th Street in Bedford Park.
- **U.S. 12/20/45 (95th St.):** \$81.7 million for bridge replacement, railroad separation replacement, intersection reconstruction and additional improvements at Stony Island Avenue in Chicago.
- **I-290 at Ridgeland Avenue, Laramie Avenue and Des Plaines River:** \$84.4 million for bridge replacements and other improvements, advance projects for eventual I-290 reconstruction. (**\$28.4 million at Ridgeland Avenue, \$23.5 million at Laramie Avenue, \$32.5 million at Des Plaines River.**)
- **Pershing Road:** \$44.2 million for bridge replacement at Racine Avenue and CN Railroad.
- **I-55:** \$41.1 million for bridge replacement at Illinois 43 in Forest View.
- **I-80:** \$27.6 million for bridge replacement at I-294 in Hazel Crest.
- **Ida B Wells Drive:** \$24.9 million for bridge superstructure replacement, superstructure rehabilitation and new bridge deck at the old post office in Chicago.
- **Willow Road:** \$22 million for reconstruction, intersection improvements and construction of additional lanes from east of Des Plaines River to Waterview Drive.
- **Illinois 43:** \$15.5 million for bridge superstructure rehabilitation and bridge repair at Sanitary and Ship Canal in Forest View.
- **Rand Road:** \$12.1 million for bridge replacement and ADA improvements at Des Plaines River.

DUPAGE

- **Illinois 56 corridor improvements:** \$33.9 million for a new bridge, reconstruction and construction of additional lanes from west of Illinois 53 to west of I-355, and at Illinois 53.

KANE

- **U.S. 20:** \$94.7 million for bridge replacements, construction of auxiliary lanes and other improvements from west of Randall Road to east of Shales Parkway in Elgin.
- **Illinois 47/U.S. 30:** \$67.2 million to improve 4.3 miles with bridge replacements, reconstruction and additional lanes, as well as other improvements from Cross Street to south of Galena Road in Sugar Grove and Yorkville.
- **U.S. 20:** \$59.4 million for interchange reconstruction, retaining walls and bridge replacement at Shales Parkway in Elgin.

LAKE

- **Illinois 60/Illinois 83:** \$111.4 million for reconstruction and additional lanes, as well as construction of a railroad grade separation from Illinois 176 (Maple Avenue) to CN Railroad in Mundelein.
- **U.S. 41:** \$49.6 million for bridge replacement, interchange reconstruction, and construction of auxiliary lanes at Illinois 176 (Rockland Road) in Lake Bluff and North Chicago.
- **Illinois 131:** \$51.5 million to improve 2.5 miles with reconstruction and additional lanes from Wadsworth Road to Sunset Avenue in Beach Park.
- **U.S. 45:** \$29 million for construction of additional lanes, reconstruction of 2 miles from Illinois 132 to Washington Street.
- **Illinois 120:** \$28.2 million for reconstruction and additional lanes from Ashford Lane to U.S. 45 in Grayslake.

MCHENRY

- **Illinois 31:** \$103.6 million for reconstruction, widening and additional lanes for 6.3 miles, drainage improvements, traffic signal modernization, ADA improvements and culvert replacement at a drainage ditch 4 miles south of U.S. 12.
- **Illinois 47:** \$85.3 million total investment. (**\$48 million for reconstruction and additional lanes, as well as intersection improvements, from north of Illinois 120 to U.S. 14 in Woodstock. \$37.3 million for intersection reconstruction at Illinois 176 (north and south junctions) and at Pleasant Valley Road.**)
- **Barrington Road:** \$17.9 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 1.5 miles from Illinois 62 to Central Road in South Barrington.

WILL

- **I-80 from Ridge Road to U.S. 30:** Total \$1 billion investment to rebuild critical freight corridor and improve safety in high-growth area. Multiple bridge replacements, including aging, obsolete structures over the Des Plaines River. Capacity enhancements include auxiliary lanes and shoulders in Joliet, New Lenox and Minooka.
- **I-55:** \$170.1 million for bridge replacements and construction of interchanges at Airport Road/Lockport Road and at Illinois 126 in Romeoville.
- **I-55:** \$140.4 million for interchange reconstruction and bridge replacement at Lorenzo Road and at Illinois 129. Auxiliary lanes and resurfacing from Illinois 129 to Lorenzo and reconstruction of the frontage roads between Kavanaugh and Lorenzo Roads.
- **U.S. 52:** \$86.9 million for reconstruction and widening of the road and bridge widening from River Road to Houbolt Road in Joliet and Shorewood.
- **Illinois 53/U.S. 52:** \$44.3 million for intersection improvements from Patterson Road to Arsenal Road in Joliet, Elwood and Wilmington.
