

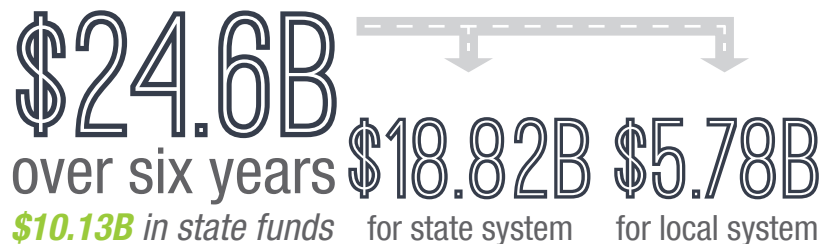

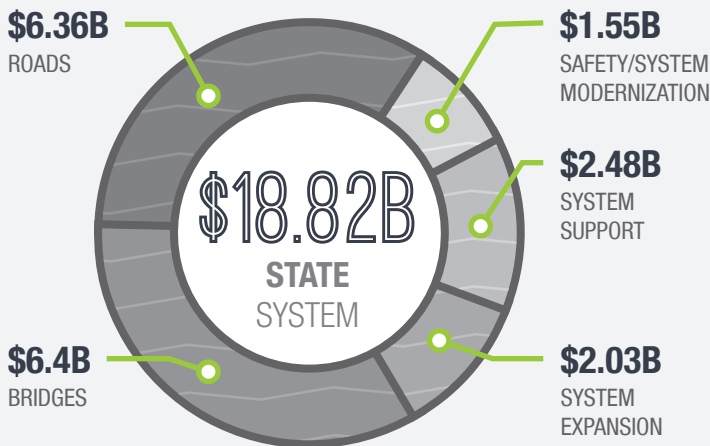
## REBUILDING OUR MYP

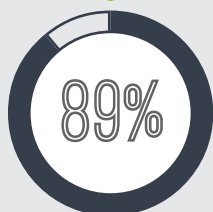

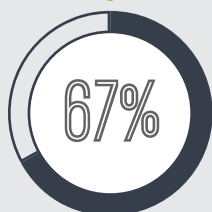

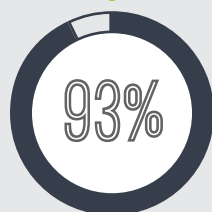

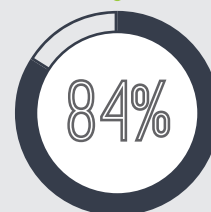


### STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

### MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

#### ADAMS

- **Illinois 104:** \$10.8 million for resurfacing 4.2 miles, traffic signal replacement and modernization, ADA improvements and other improvements from 12th Street to I-172.

#### CASS

- **Beardstown Bridge:** \$75 million for new U.S. 67/Illinois 100 bridge over the Illinois River. The new structure will replace one that has been subject to weight restrictions in the past due to its condition.

#### CHRISTIAN

- **Illinois 48:** \$10.7 million for resurfacing 15.2 miles, ADA and drainage improvements from Old Illinois 48 to Montgomery County line.

#### HANCOCK

- **U.S. 136/South Second Street:** \$13.9 million for vertical realignment on 0.8 mile, bridge replacement, railroad crossing improvement and other improvements from the Mississippi River to Main Street in Hamilton.

#### MONTGOMERY

- **I-55:** \$13 million for resurfacing 5.5 miles from south of Waggoner to Macoupin Creek.

#### PIKE

- **Florence Bridge:** \$79 million for new Illinois 100/106 bridge over the Illinois River, replacing structurally deficient, functionally obsolete structure built in 1929.

#### SANGAMON

- **I-55:** \$124.2 million for additional lanes and reconstruction along 7.8 miles, including ramp repair, bridge replacement, bridge widening and other improvements from Illinois 54/Sangamon Avenue in Springfield to 2.7 miles south of Illinois 123.
- **Illinois 97/125:** \$76.4 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 6.5 miles, bridge replacement, intersection reconstruction, bridge removal, pedestrian overpass and other improvements from Illinois 97/125 junction to Illinois 4.
- **MacArthur Boulevard:** \$28 million for reconstruction of 1.5 miles, traffic signal replacement, ADA improvements and other improvements from Wabash/Stanford Avenue to South Grand Avenue in Springfield.
- **I-55:** \$18.5 million for resurfacing 6.2 miles, bridge deck overlay, bridge repairs and other improvements from Illinois 104 to Horse Farm Road.
- **I-55 Business/Sixth Street:** \$40.4 million for reconstruction and additional lanes on 3.9 miles, turning lanes, sidewalks and other improvements from I-72 to north of Stanford Avenue in Springfield.
