

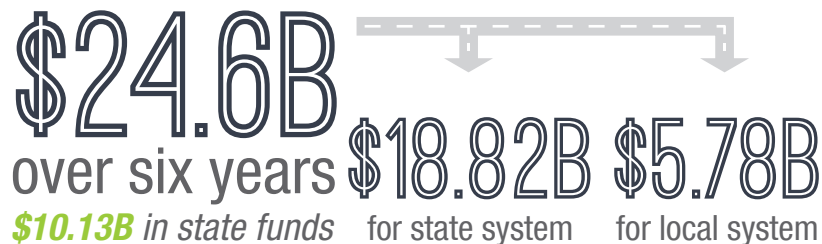

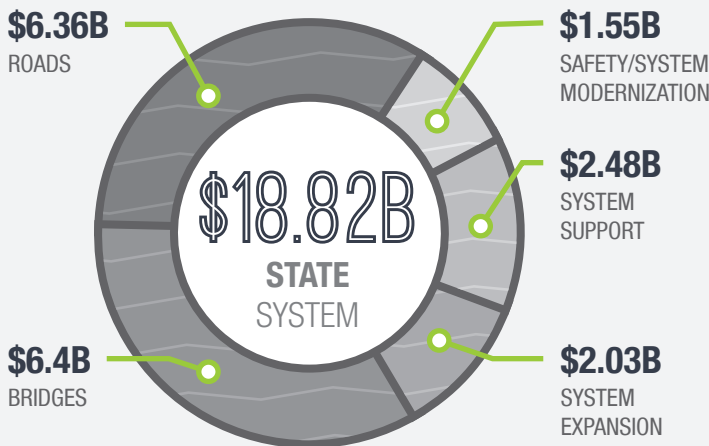
REBUILDING OUR MYP

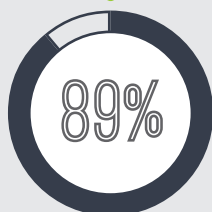

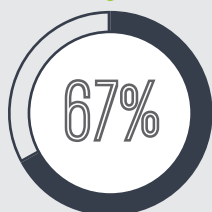

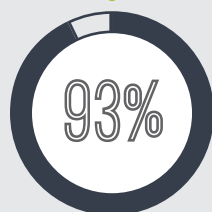


NON-INTERSTATES

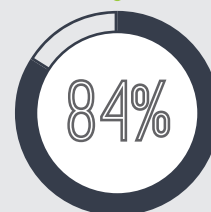


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

ALEXANDER

- **U.S. 51/60/62:** \$120.5 million for bridge replacement over the Ohio River one mile south of Cairo.

FRANKLIN

- **Illinois 154:** \$11.3 million for bridge replacement and adding a bikeway from Larry Foster Parkway to Fitzgerald Park Drive at Rend Lake.

FRANKLIN & JEFFERSON

- **I-57:** \$113 million for additional lanes for 16.5 miles and bridge replacements along critical freight corridor from 2.5 miles south of Illinois 154 to the I-64 south tri-level interchange in Mount Vernon.
- **Illinois 37:** \$33.6 million for resurfacing 13.8 miles from Campground Road in Bonnie to Illinois 14 in Benton.

JEFFERSON

- **I-57/I-64:** \$48 million for interchange reconstruction and bridge replacement at the Illinois 15 Interchange in Mount Vernon.

JOHNSON & UNION

- **I-57:** \$29.3 million for reconstructing 12.7 miles of northbound lanes from Illinois 146 to I-24.

PERRY

- **Illinois 152:** \$13.5 million for resurfacing 6.8 miles from Illinois 127 to U.S. 51.

UNION

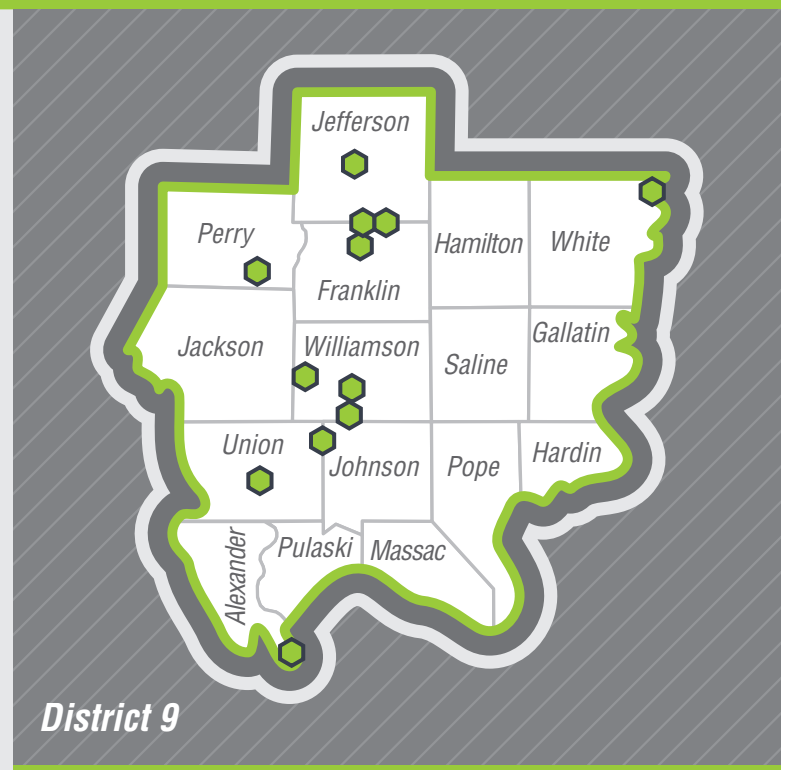
- **Illinois 146:** \$10.5 million for reconstruction of 1.4 miles from Illinois 127 to Old U.S. 51 in Anna.

WHITE

- **I-64:** \$116.6 million for a bridge replacement at Wabash River.

WILLIAMSON

- **Illinois 13:** \$33 million for additional lanes for two miles, bridge replacement and bridge widening from Spillway Road to Shawnee Trail.
- **I-24:** \$21.2 million for resurfacing 13.6 miles and bridge deck overlays from I-57 to U.S. 45 north of Vienna.
- **I-57:** \$42 million for additional lanes for 7.9 miles from I-24 to south of Old Illinois 13 in Marion.
