

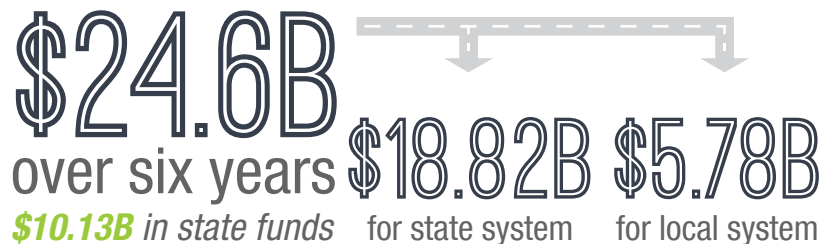

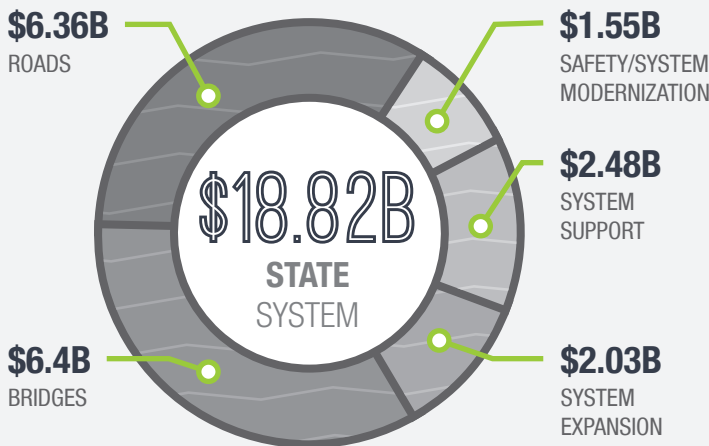
REBUILDING OUR MYP

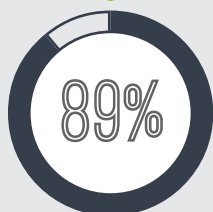

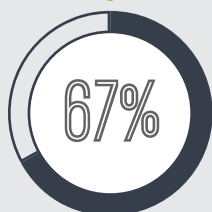

INTERSTATES

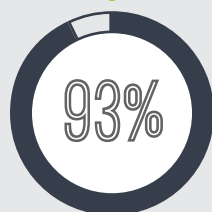


NON-INTERSTATES

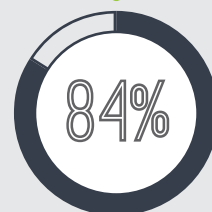


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

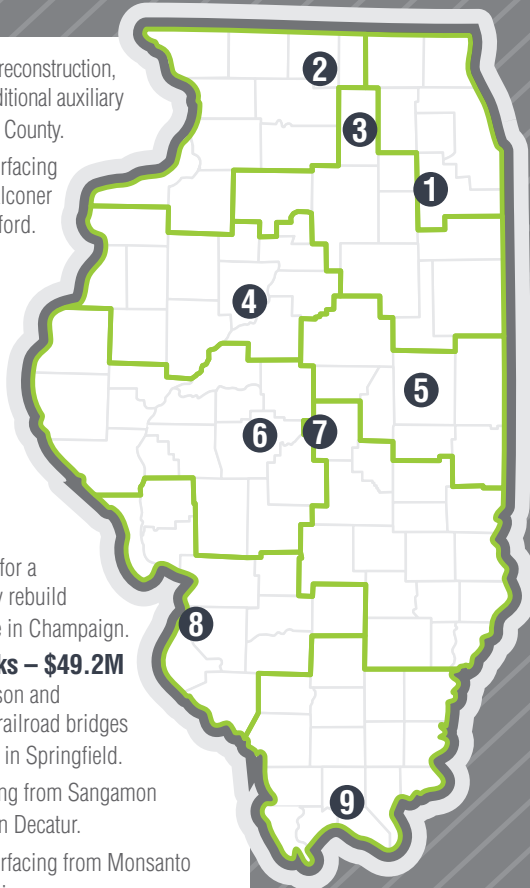

THREE YEARS OF REBUILDING

PROJECTS UNDERWAY

- 1 **I-55 – \$54M** for interchange reconstruction, new bridge, bridge repair and additional auxiliary lanes from I-80 to U.S. 52 in Will County.
- 2 **U.S. 20 – \$14.5M** for resurfacing and pavement patching from Falconer Road to Simpson Road in Rockford.
- 3 **Illinois 38 – \$3.7M** for resurfacing from Jon Huber Parkway to Fourth Street (Illinois 23) in DeKalb.
- 4 **I-474 – \$20.9M** for resurfacing from the Illinois River to I-74, including ramps at Adams Street, Airport Road and Maxwell Road in Peoria.
- 5 **I-57/74 Interchange Rehabilitation – \$120M** for a multi-year project to completely rebuild and reconfigure the interchange in Champaign.
- 6 **10th Street Railroad tracks – \$49.2M** to create an underpass at Madison and Jefferson streets, and to create railroad bridges and add a second railroad track in Springfield.
- 7 **I-72 – \$20.8M** for resurfacing from Sangamon County line to west of U.S. 51 in Decatur.
- 8 **Illinois 3 – \$6.6M** for resurfacing from Monsanto Avenue to Ruby Street in Cahokia.
- 9 **I-24 – \$100.3M** for improving I-24 from Metropolis to I-57 in Massac, Johnson and Williamson counties.
