Enclosed for your approval and use in accordance with paragraph 23 CFR 450.220 is a copy of an amendment to the FY 2021-2024 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for Illinois. The Department of Transportation (IDOT) is authorizing this amendment to the STIP.

The projects listed in this amendment are for local program projects that are not in a Metropolitan Planning Organization area. The projects were placed in a local newspaper for a 15-day comment period. One comment was received. Therefore, the public involvement requirements are met.
