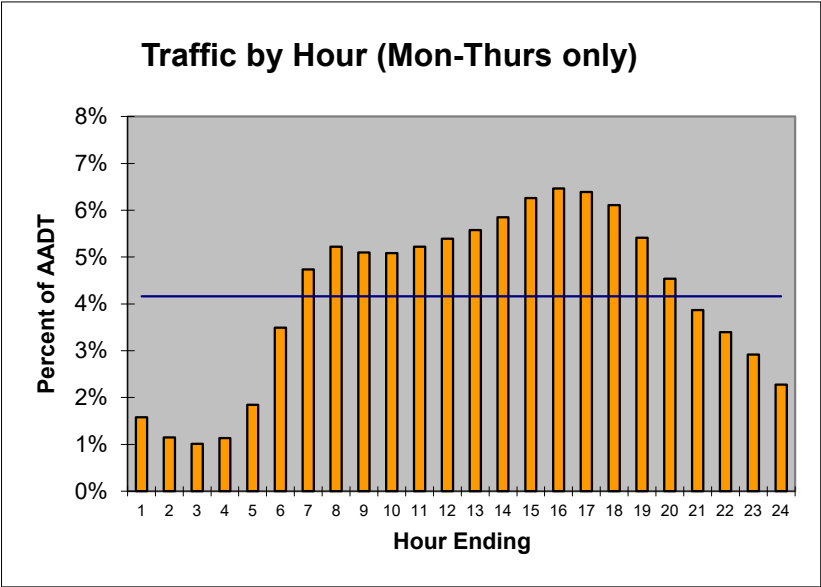
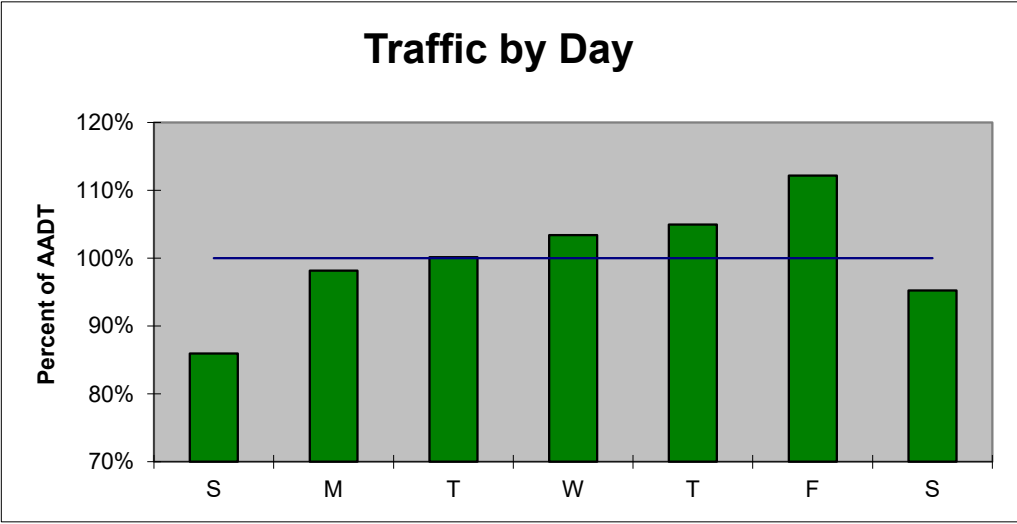
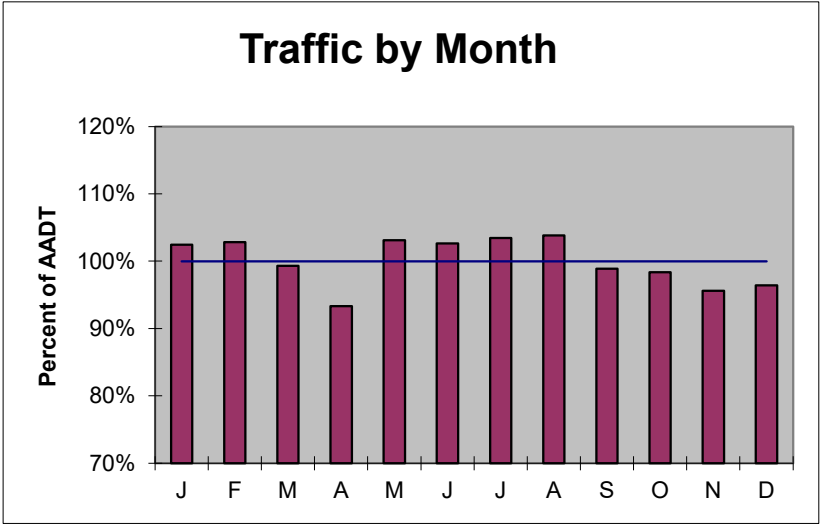

AADT - Annual Average Daily Traffic

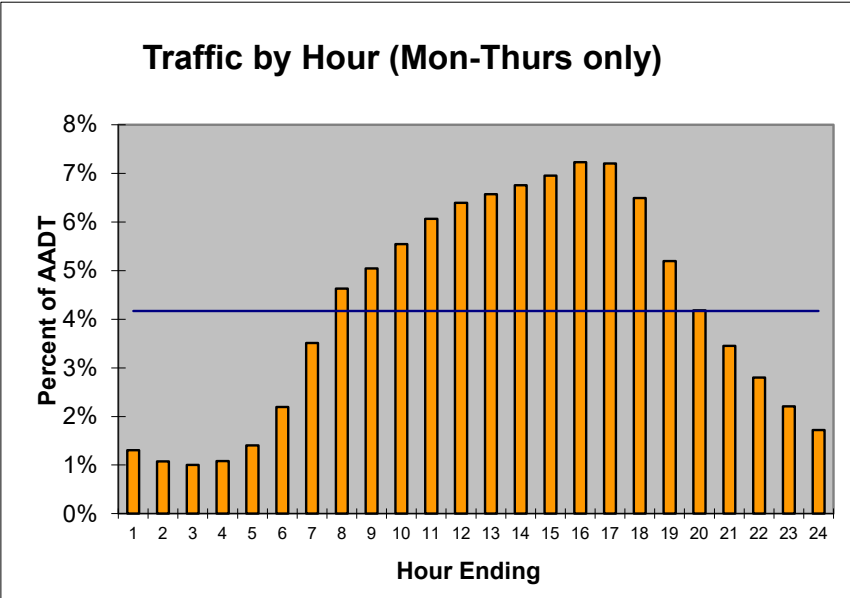
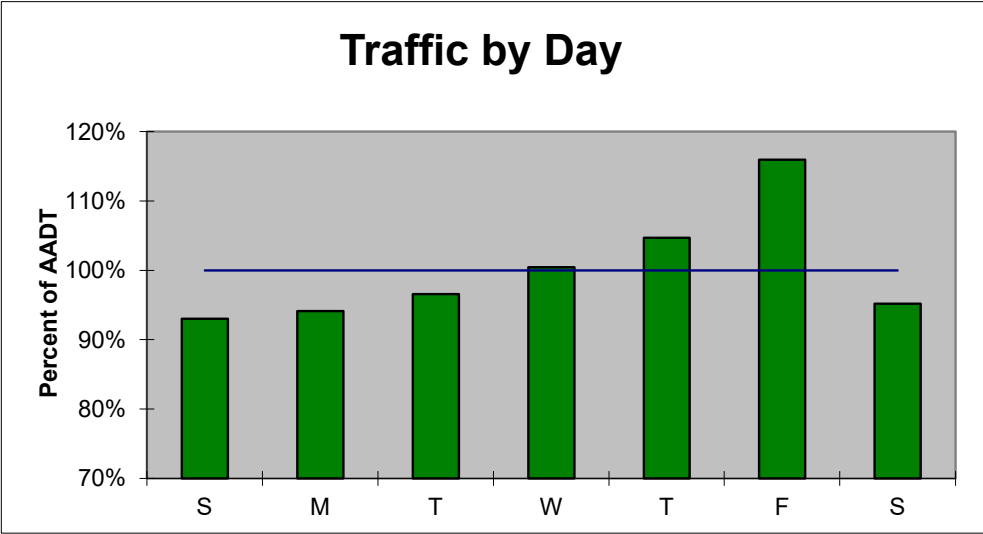
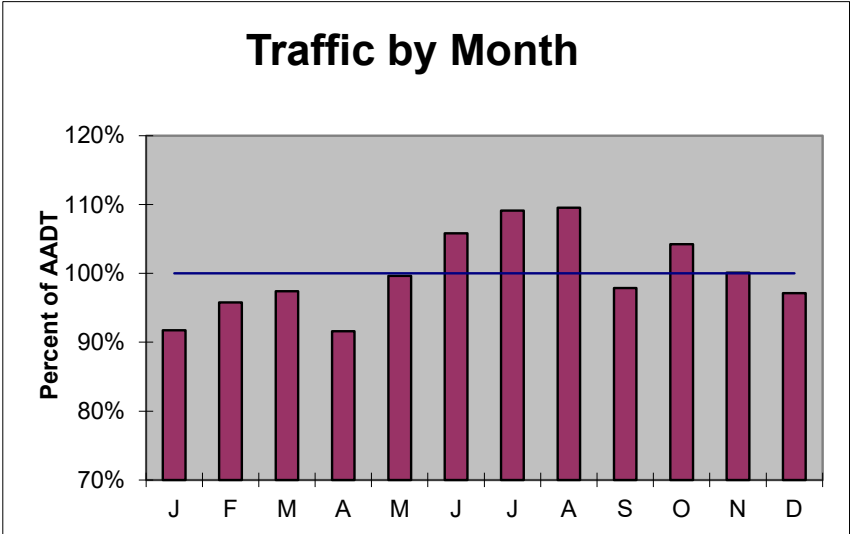
Data from 3 continuous count sites throughout Northeastern Illinois during 2017 - 2020 were used to determine these travel patterns.

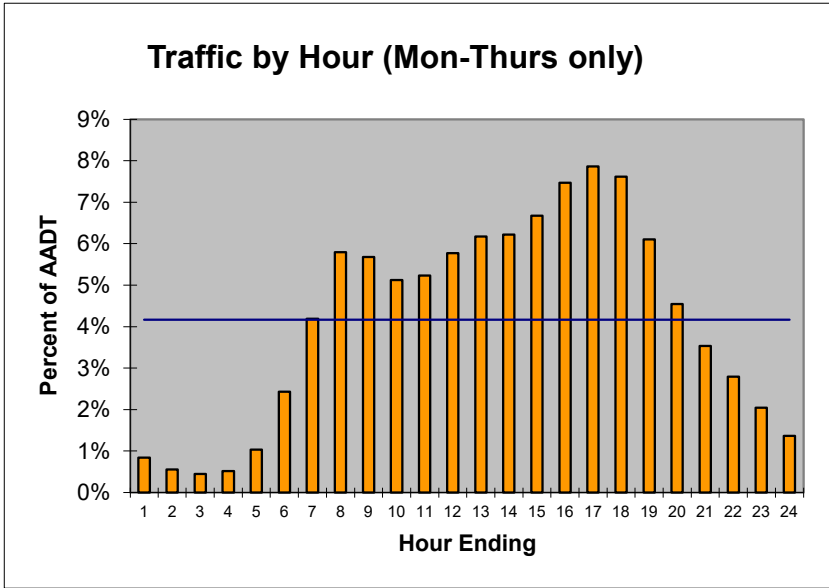
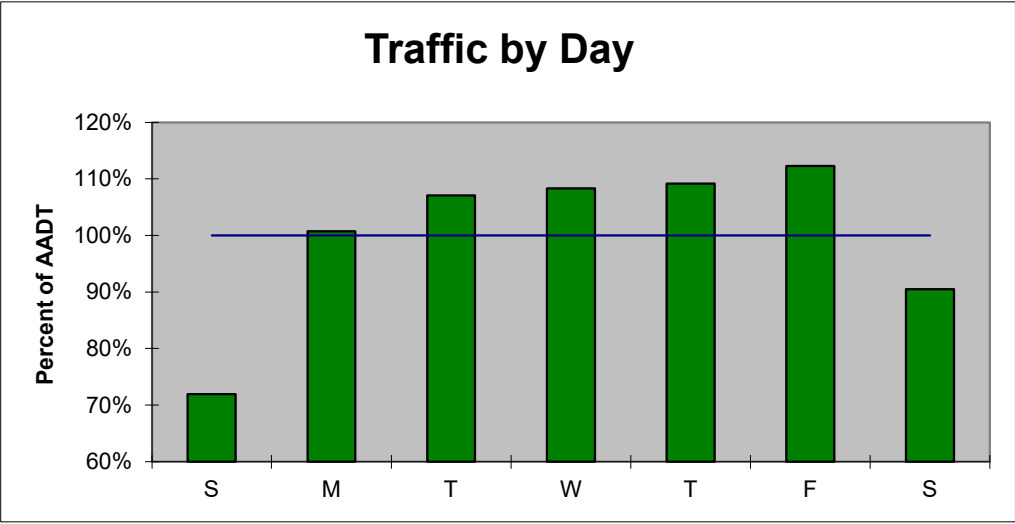
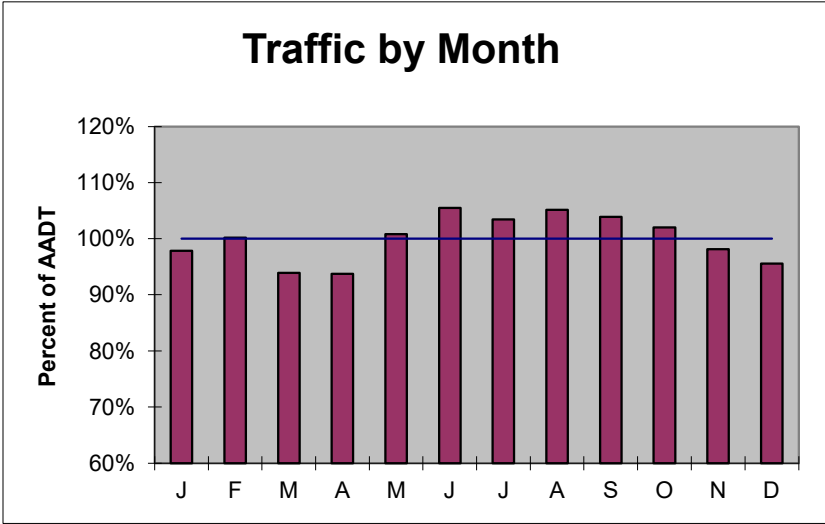
Data from 19 continuous count sites throughout Illinois during 2017 - 2020 were used to determine these travel patterns.

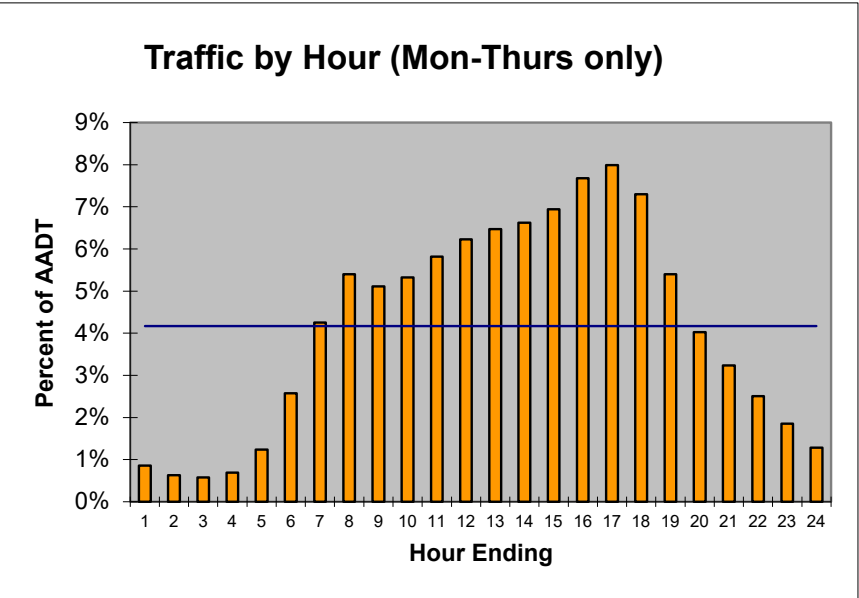

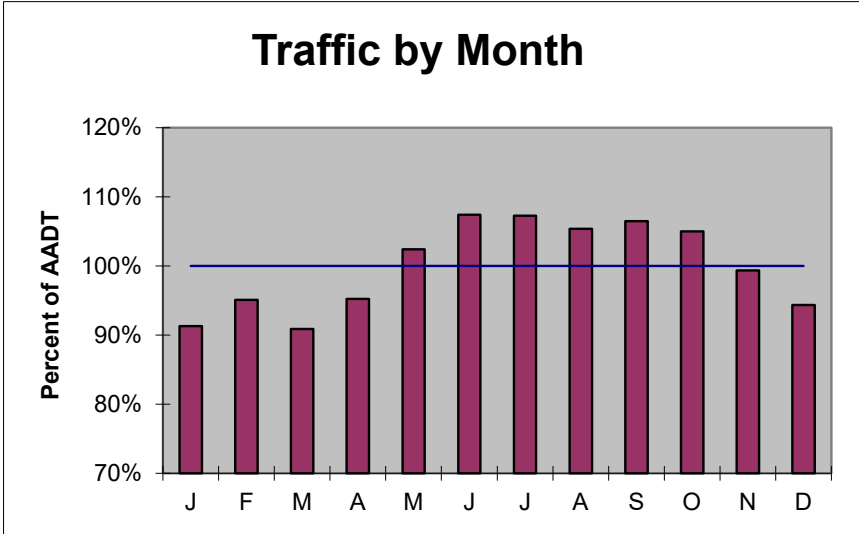

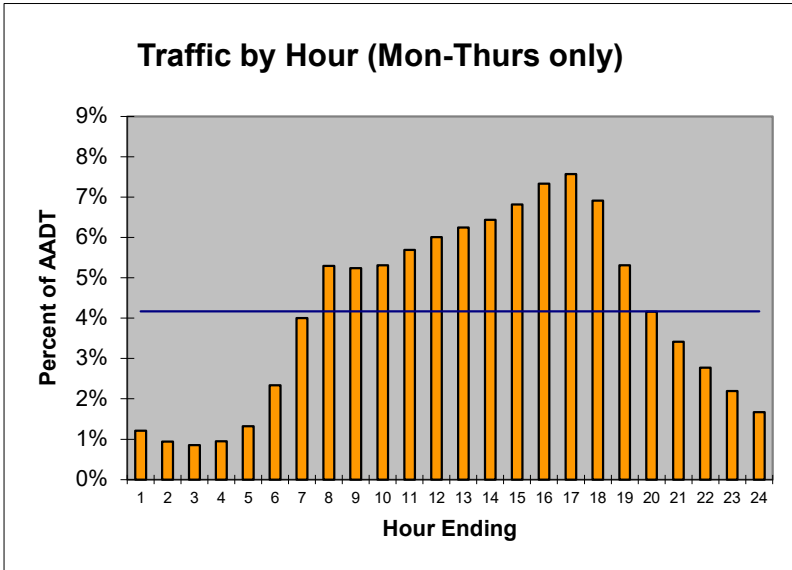
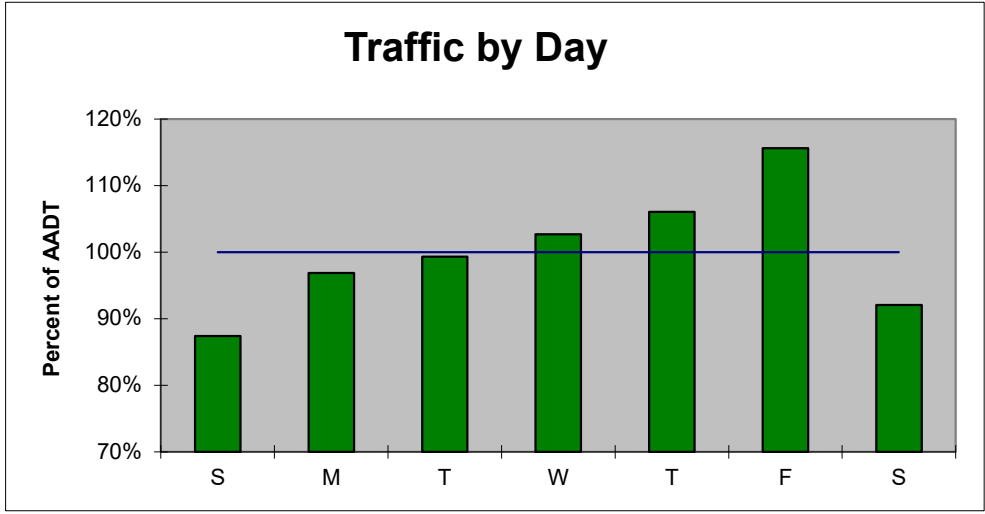
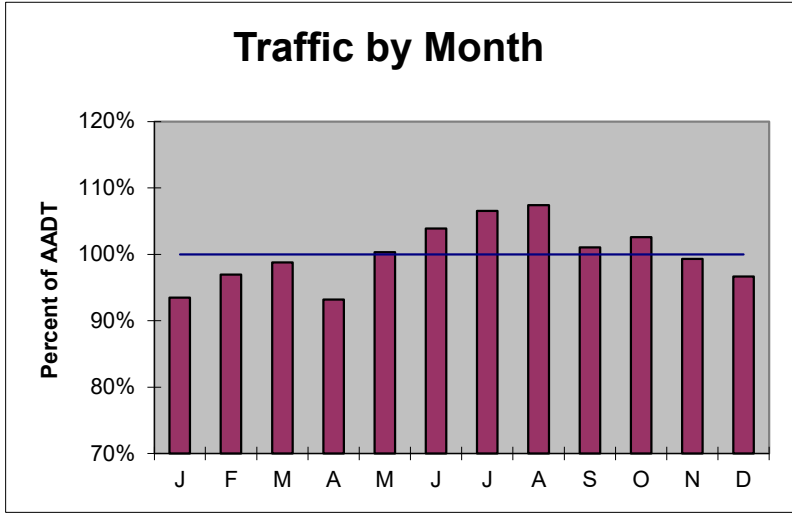

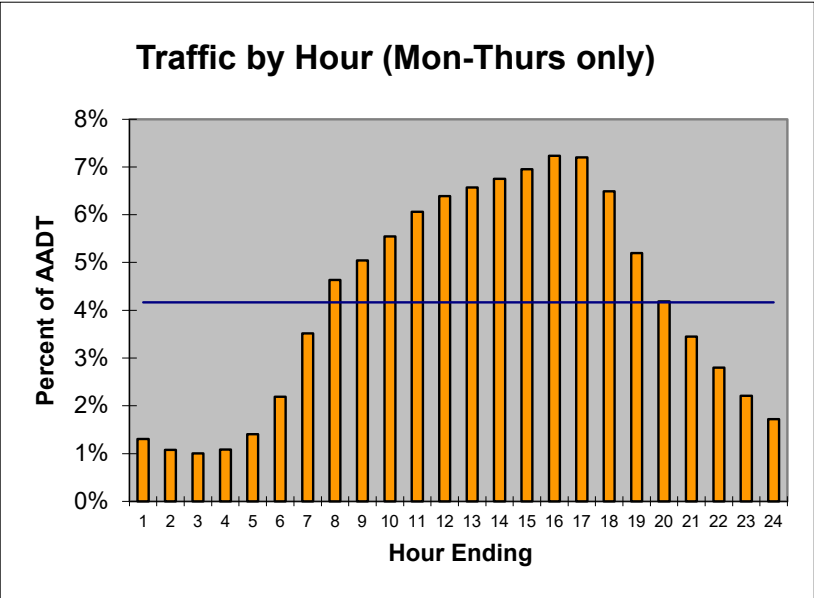

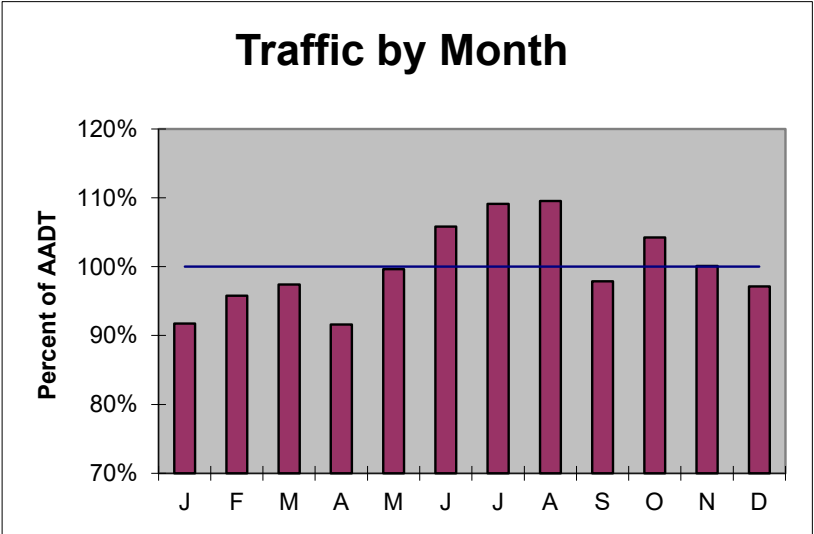

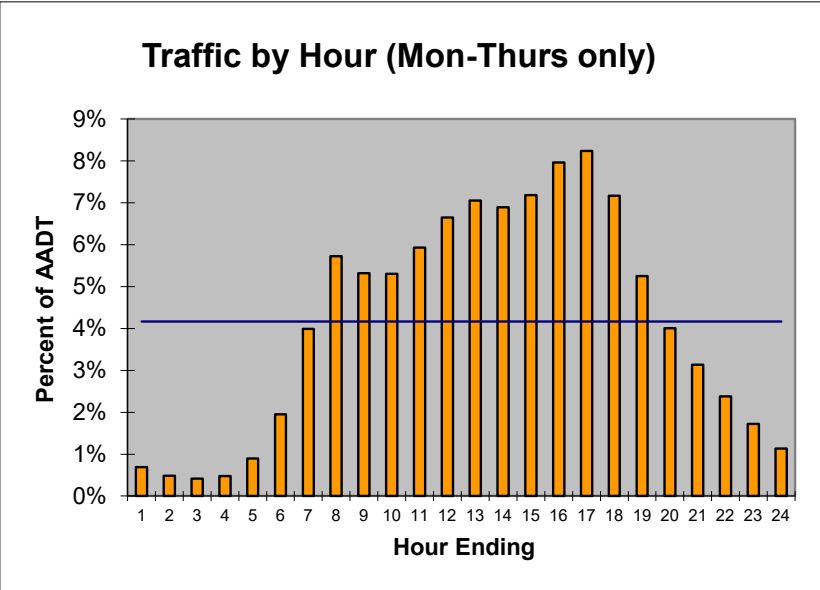
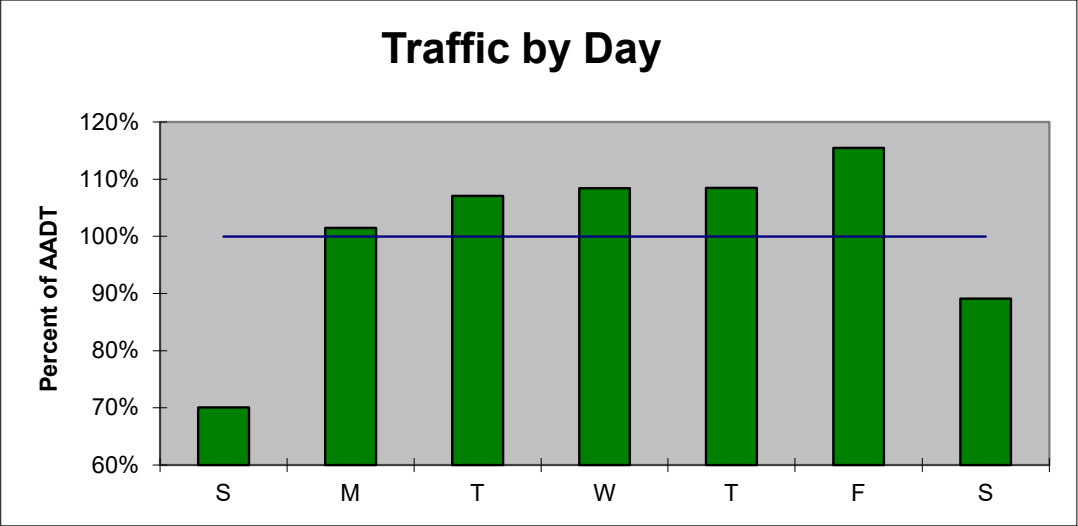
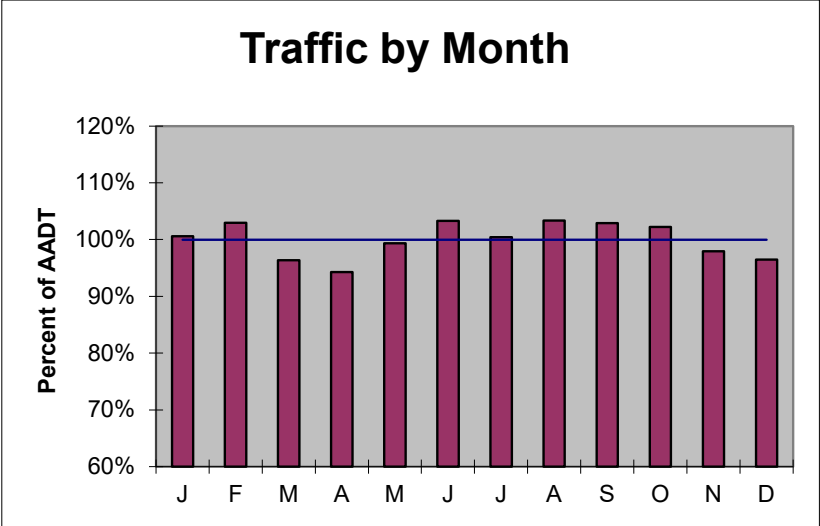

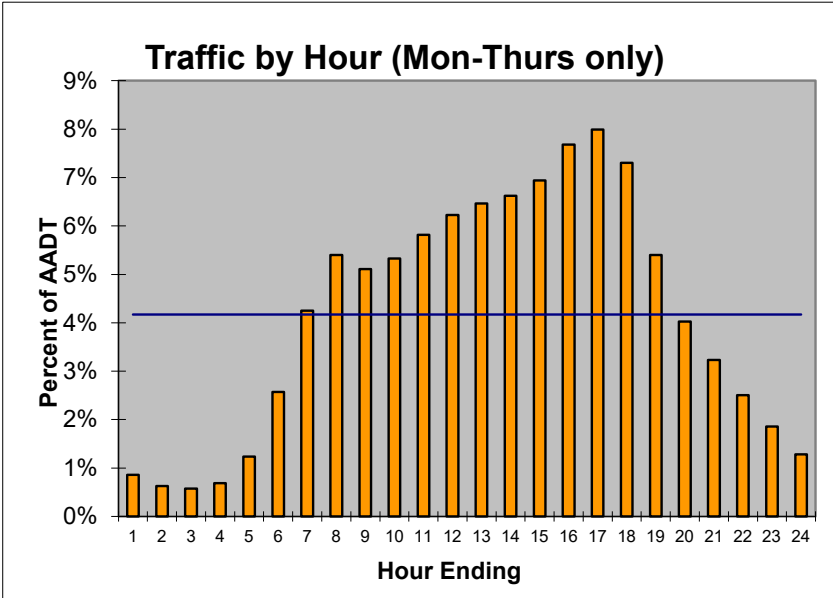
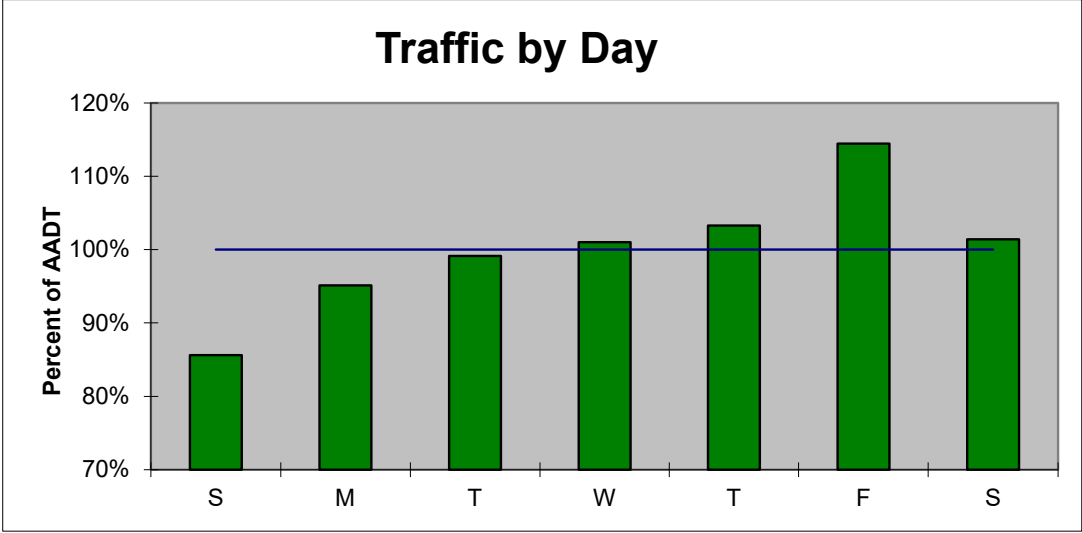
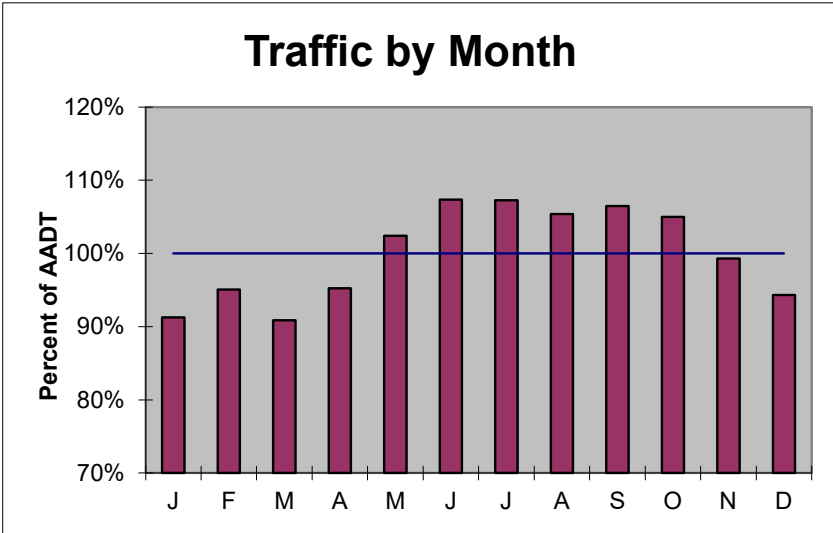
