Listed below are the changes reflected in revision #1 to Illinois' FY 2015 Highway Safety Plan:

1. Task number 02-05, Section 402 (DTS). New task. This task provides \$18,000.00 in federal funds for DTS to conduct a Driver Education Assessment of Illinois.
2. Task number 02-06, Section 402 (DTS). New task. This task provides \$20,000.00 in federal funds for DTS to host the National Lifesavers Conference.
3. Task number 19-11, Section 405b (DTS). The task narrative has been revised to reflect the 2014 Halloween paid media campaign.
4. Task number 18-02, Section 408 (IDPH). The programmed amount increased from \$156,000.00 to \$156,500.00.
5. Task number 18-03, Section 408 (CDOT). New task. This task provides \$461,976.00 in federal Section 408 funds for Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT) to conduct a crash data project.
6. Task number 23-01, Section 1906 (DTS). The programmed amount increased from \$93,000.00 to \$114,846.00.
7. Task number 23-03, Section 1906 (DTS). The programmed amount decreased from \$2,000.00 to \$500.00.
8. Federal funding levels. Based on the 2014 final reimbursement voucher, carryforward amounts changed the amounts of federal funding to program in the following funding areas: Section 405b Occupant Protection, Section 405c Data, Section 405d Impaired Driving, Section 405f Motorcycle Safety and Section 1906 Racial Profiling.
