## **Public hearing April 25 on U.S. 20 ramp project in Kane County**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a public hearing will be held Thursday, April 25, on a proposed project to improve the U.S. 20 ramps at Illinois and Lavoie avenues, in Kane County. The proposed project is anticipated to consist of closing the existing U.S. 20 ramps at Illinois and Lavoie avenues and modifying both roads to accommodate the closures.

The purpose of the hearing is to inform the public about the project development process, present the preferred alternatives and obtain public input. The public hearing will be in an open-house format at the following time and location:
