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U.S. 150 north of Ophiem Road in Henry County closes May 6

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that U.S. 150 at the BNSF Railroad crossing in Henry County will be closed from Monday, May 6, through Saturday, May 11. The crossing is north of Ophiem Road.

The closure will allow the railroad to remove and replace its at-grade crossing and repave the approaches. A marked detour will direct traffic to use Illinois 81, Interstate 74 and Illinois 17.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
