I-74 ramp, lane closures begin April 17 Work on University Avenue in Urbana to last until August

URBANA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced closures on the ramps to and from westbound Interstate 74 at University Avenue/U.S. 150 (exit 185) in Urbana begin April 17.

The closures are necessary for rehabilitation of the University Avenue ramp bridge over I-74. The project also will reduce westbound I-74 to one lane at the interchange. Detours for the ramp closures will be posted during the duration of the work, which is expected to be complete in August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the <u>next six years</u>, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,000 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. <u>Accomplishments</u> through Year Four of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$12.1 billion of improvements statewide on 5,339 miles of highway, 533 bridges and 762 additional safety improvements.
