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Illinois 96 in Adams County to close June 1

QUINCY – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that a culvert replacement on Illinois 96 north of Quincy in Adams County will begin Saturday, June 1.

The work zone is just north of the Illinois 96 and Ellington Road intersection. Illinois 96 will be closed at that location and a detour utilizing U.S. 24 and Illinois 104 (Broadway Street) will be posted. This \$2 million project will improve and help maintain drainage across the road. The road is expected to open in mid-July.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the [next six years](#), IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,000 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. [Accomplishments](#) through Year Four of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$12.1 billion of improvements statewide on 5,339 miles of highway, 533 bridges and 762 additional safety improvements.
