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Illinois 89 bridge replacements begin May 13

McNABB – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that replacement of two bridges on Illinois 89, north of Illinois 18 between McNabb and Magnolia in rural Putnam County, begins May 13.

The work will replace bridges over Clear Creek and Clear Creek Tributary with box culverts and will reduce Illinois 89 to one lane, with traffic controlled by temporary signals, into December.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
