Become a **Civil Engineer Trainee** at the Illinois Department of Transportation. **All engineering majors are** eligible.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of a bachelor of science degree in engineering from an ABET accredited college (including those expecting to graduate in the next 12 months) **or** a current Illinois Engineer Intern Certificate **or** a current Professional Engineer license in the State of Illinois **or** a current Structural Engineer License in the State of Illinois.
- Those applying with only a degree must have a minimum of 2.0 (out of 4.0) cumulative Grade Point Average. If cumulative GPA is between 2.0 and 2.5 (out of 4.0), applicants must also possess a current Illinois Engineer Intern Certificate **or** a current Professional Engineer license in the State of Illinois **or** a current Structural Engineer License in the State of Illinois.
