**Procedure for Certifying a New
Longitudinal Joint Sealant
or Full Lane Sealant**

Effective: [September 15, 2017](#)

A. Scope

Before materials can be used for a Department project, the manufacturer/supplier must have a producer/supplier number assigned to their facility. The producer/supplier must generate a quality history with production batches of longitudinal joint sealant. This quality history is obtained by producing material to be tested and approved by the Bureau of Materials. The following guidelines are provided to clarify the submittal requirements and expedite the process.

B. Certified Producer/Materials by Policy Memorandum

Performance Graded Asphalts are certified by Policy Memorandum 1-08.1 "Performance Graded Asphalt Binder Acceptance Procedure" which can be found at the Internet link [below](#). The longitudinal joint sealant is very similar to performance graded asphalt binder and will be certified according to the same Policy Memorandum 1-08.1 with the following exceptions: Articles 3.1.9 and 3.4.1.4 of the policy memorandum will be excluded.
