In 2006, a Federal requirement directed states to create a new Highway Safety Improvement Program that requires states to document the top 5 percent of its locations that exhibit the most severe safety needs.

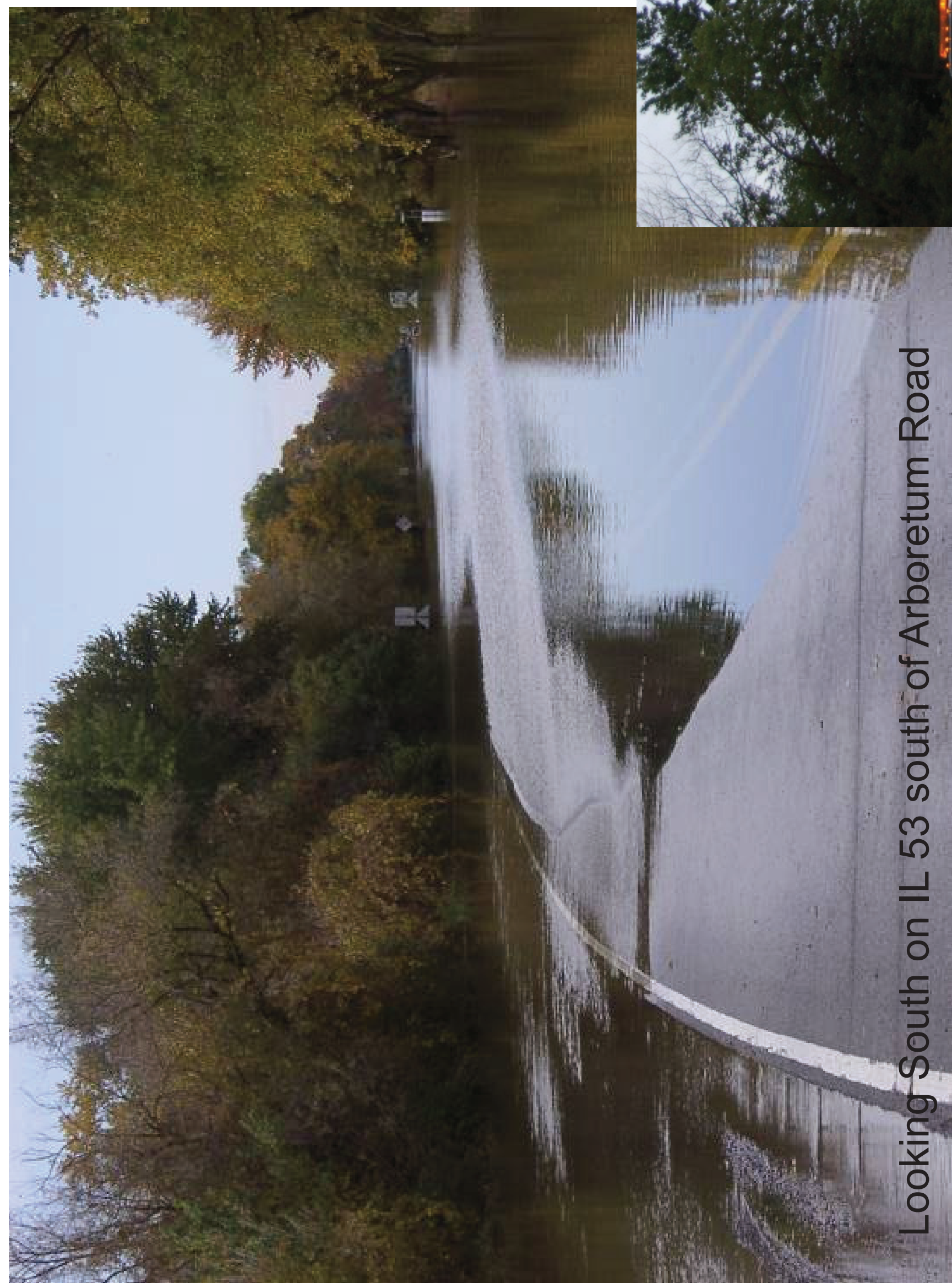
As part of the Illinois

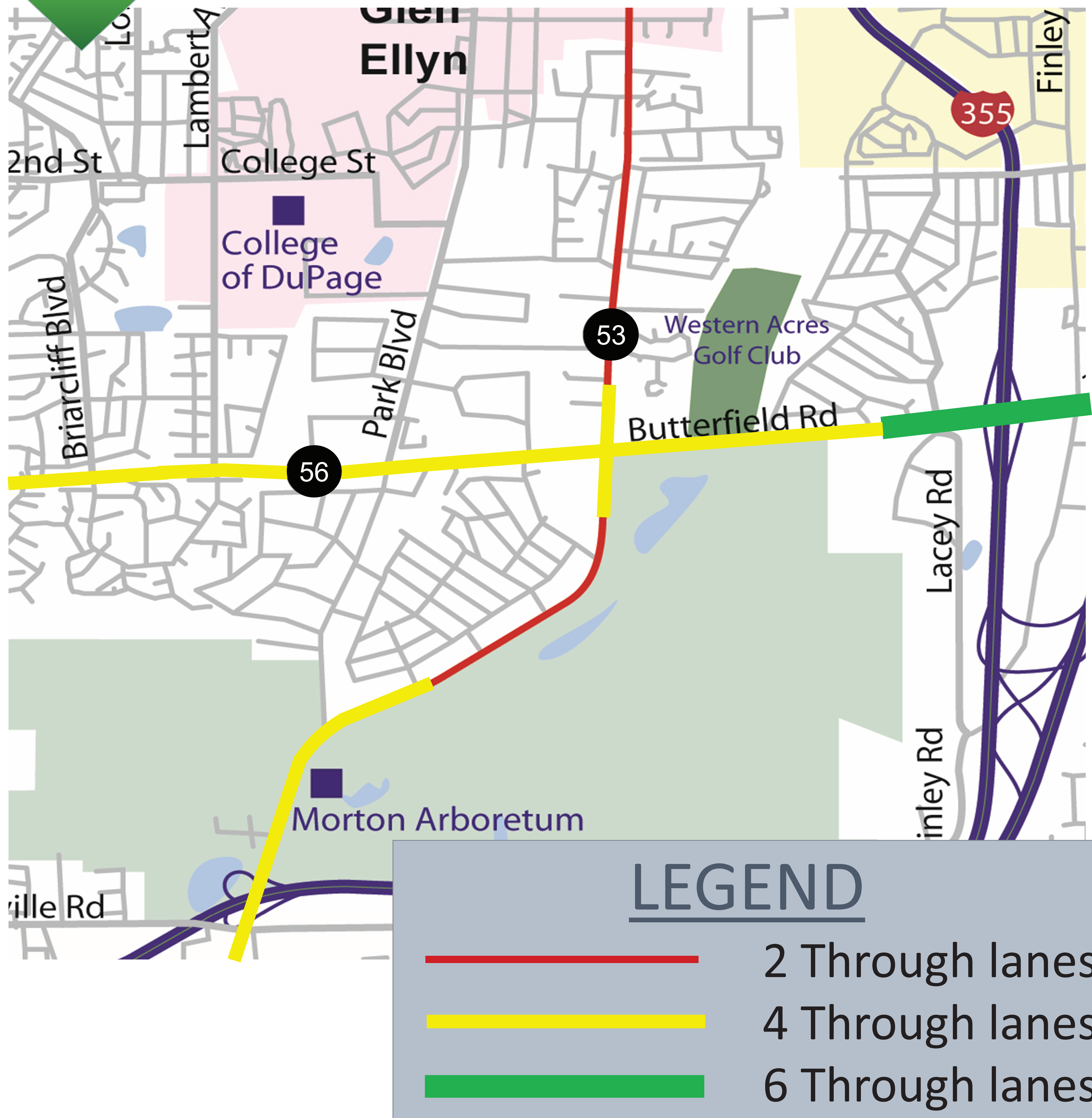

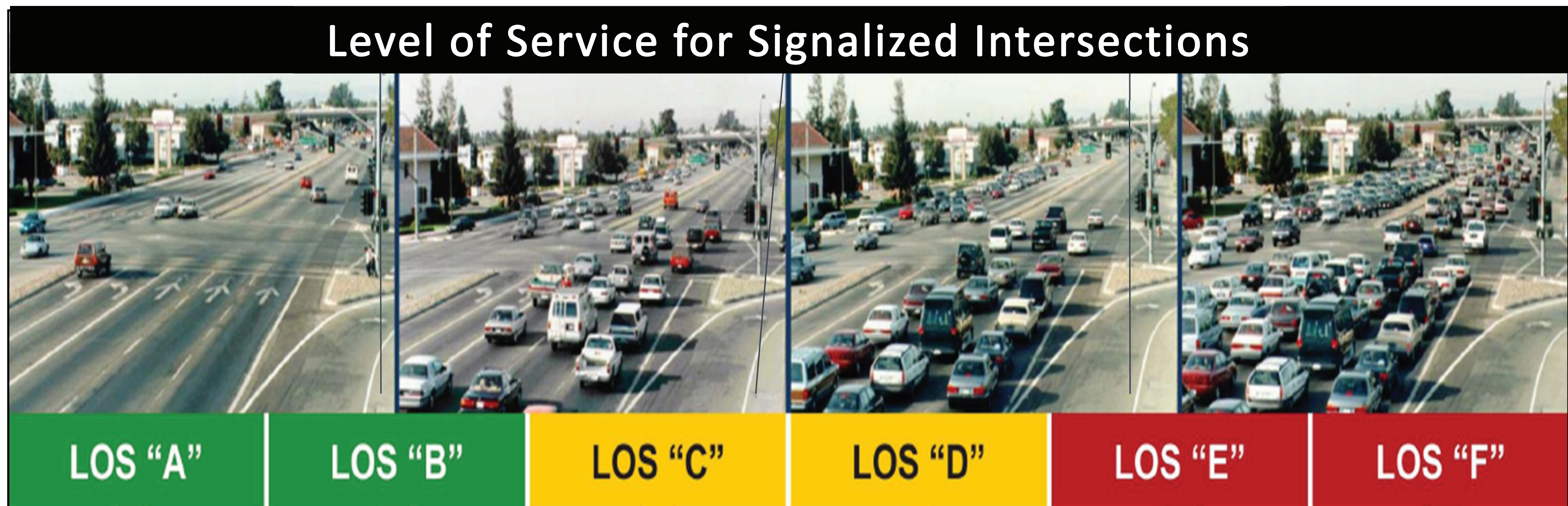
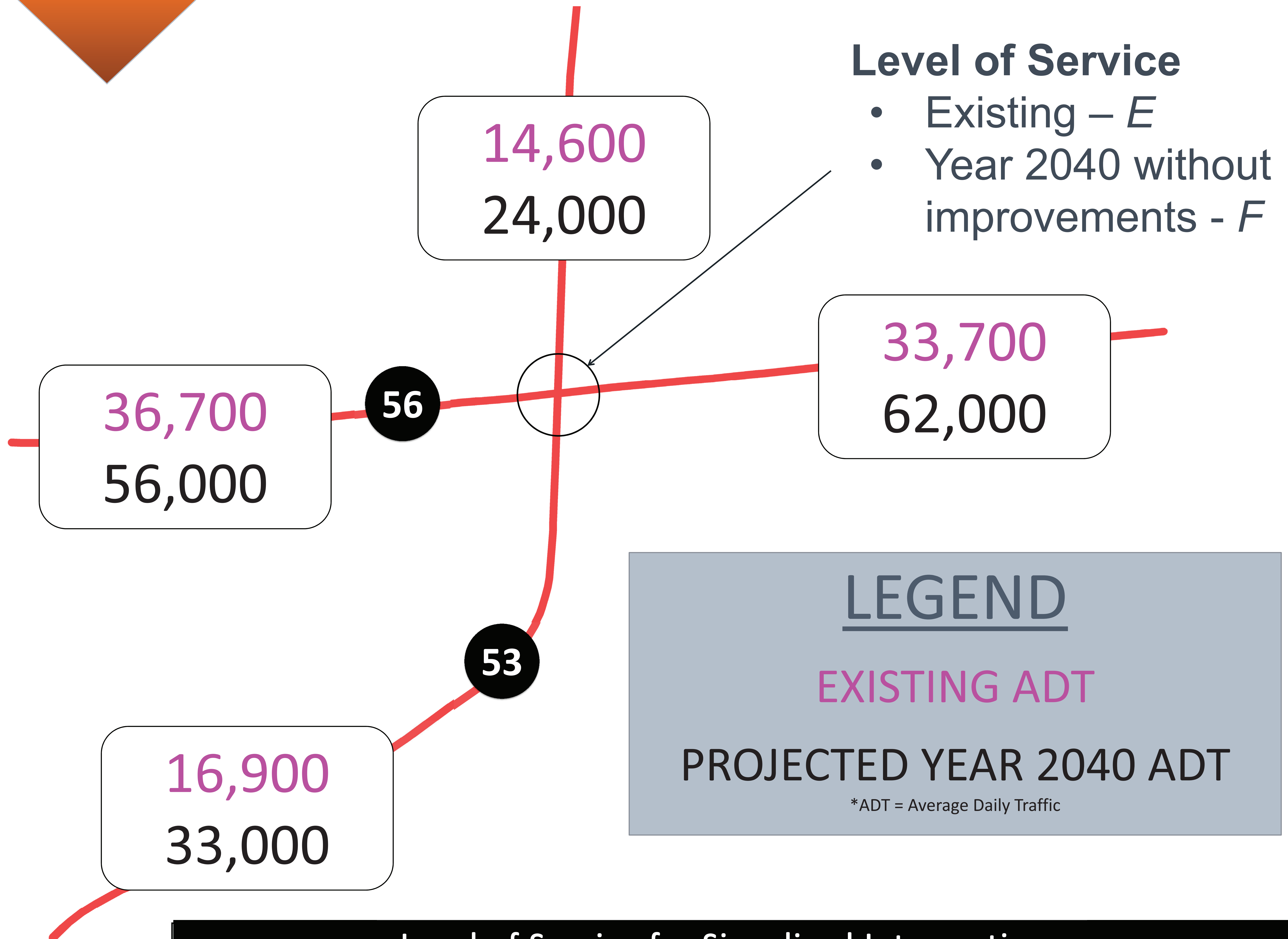
