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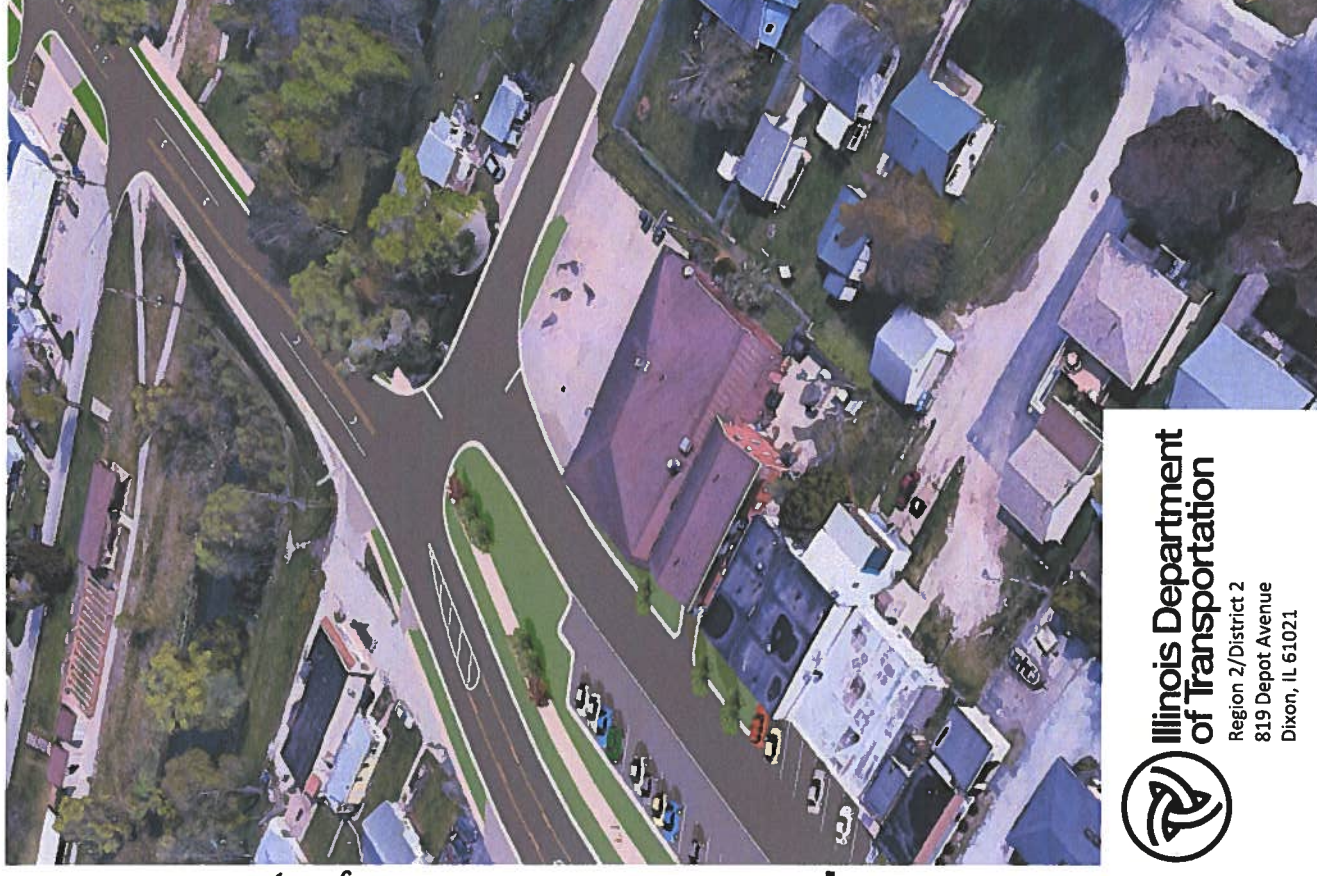

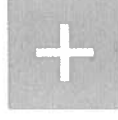
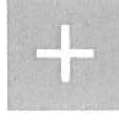

Public Informational Open House

Welcome to the public informational open house for the project study of IL 84 through Colona from the Rock River to 0.2 miles north of US 6. Personnel from the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) are here to provide information regarding preliminary project details, the study schedule and process, study area characteristics, and public involvement opportunities. Attendees will have an opportunity to review exhibits, provide comments, and meet with IDOT representatives on a one-on-one basis.

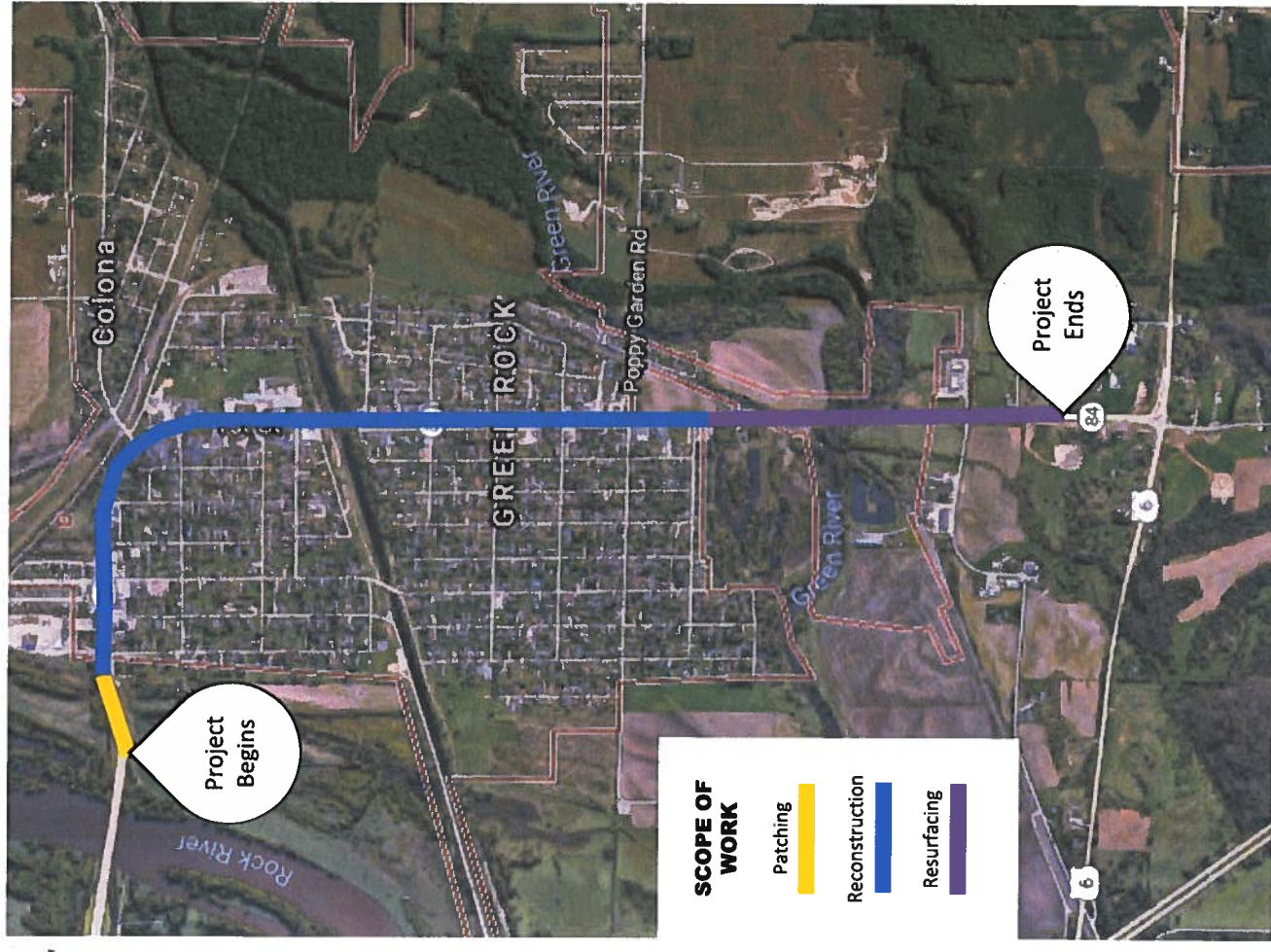


WHAT'S NEXT?

We value your views.

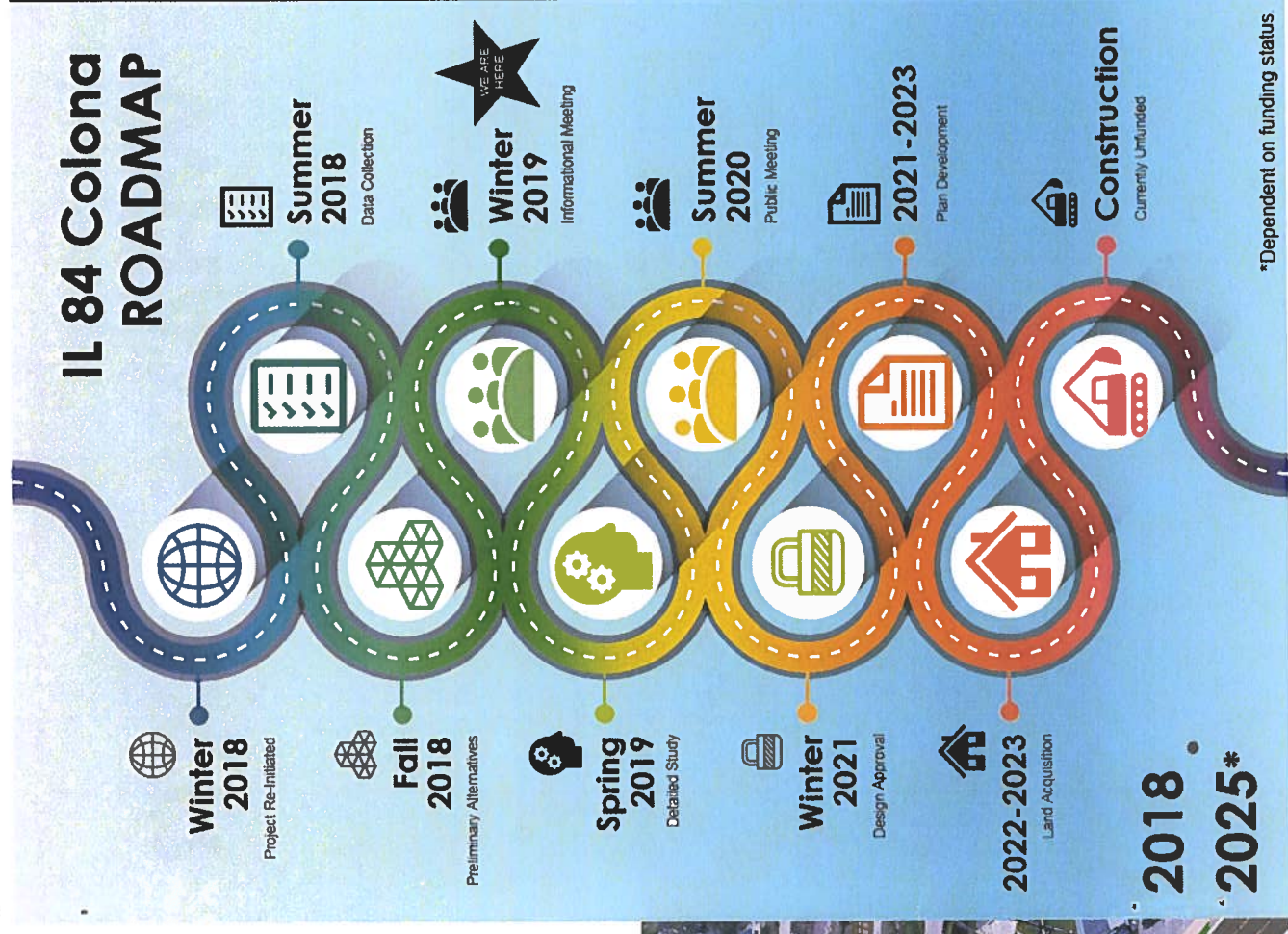
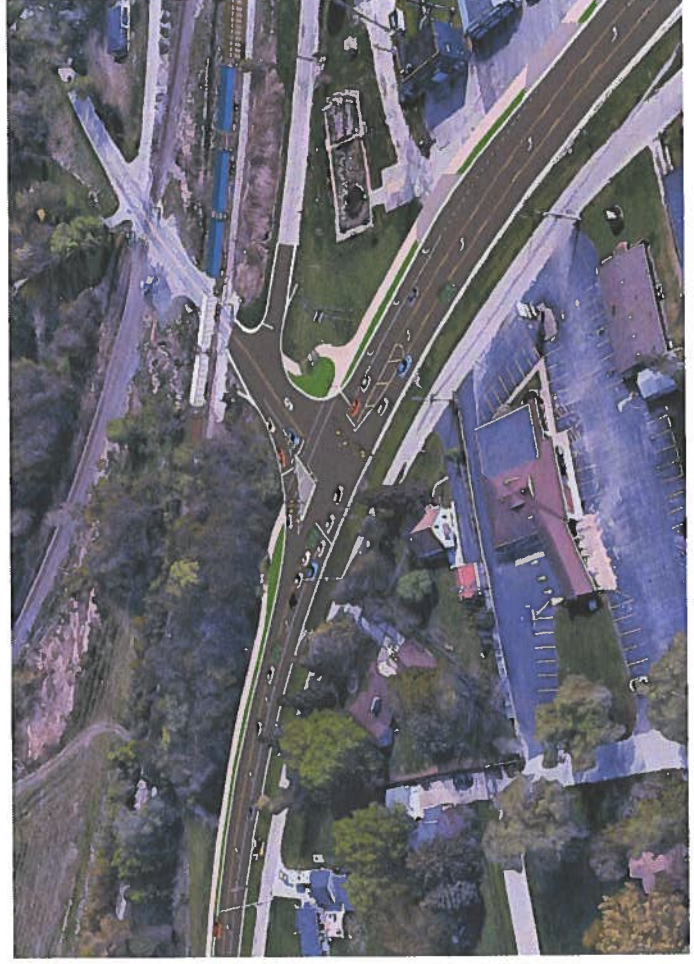
Personnel from IDOT will review your feedback. Recommendations for revision to proposed design elements will be evaluated for adherence to state and federal policies. Every comment form will receive a response. The study team will make changes deemed practicable and feasible, and continue to analyze environmental impacts. After design elements have been finalized, IDOT will return to Colona to provide the community with an update and solicit additional feedback. We anticipate that the next Public Meeting/Hearing will occur in the summer of 2020. Construction is currently unfunded.

PROPOSED LIMITS OF IMPROVEMENT

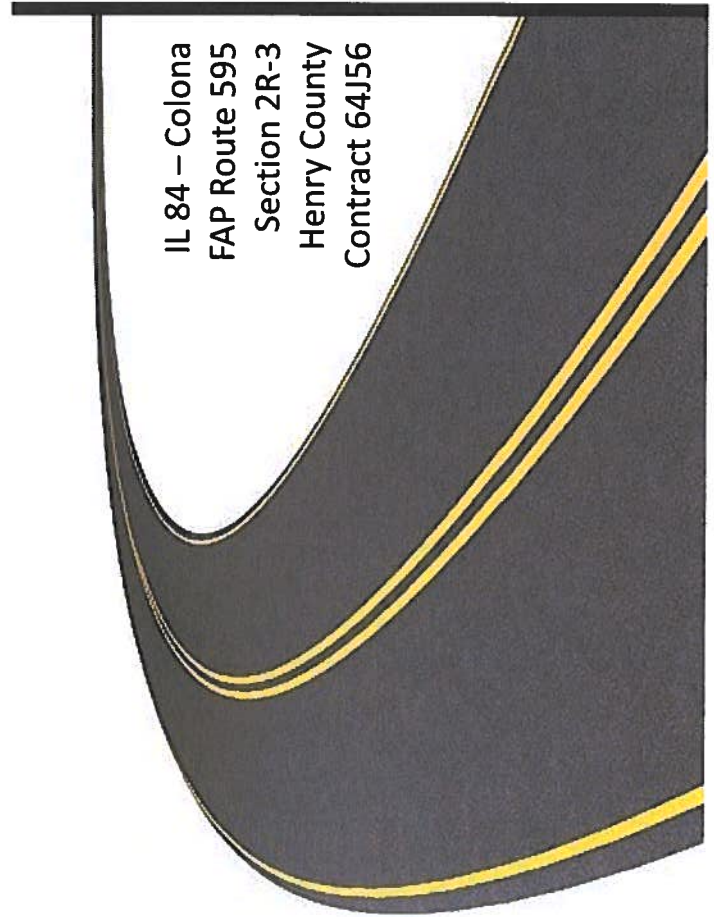


Scope of Work

Based on traffic demands that have caused safety and operational concerns, and deterioration of the existing pavement condition, IDOT has identified a need to improve IL 84 through Colona. The scope of work includes reconstruction, pavement patching, and resurfacing. For the majority of the project, the proposed roadway cross section will consist of two thru lanes and a bi-directional left-turn lane. Right-turn lanes will be installed at Cleveland Road and 7th Street. The intersection at Cleveland Road will become signalized with an extended left-turn lane to store turning vehicles delayed by daily train crossings. Other improvements include: ADA ramps, 10-ft multi-use path, sidewalk, increased separation between frontage road and state route, curb & gutter, drainage, mailbox turnouts, and parking along Green Park Avenue from 5th Avenue to 6th Avenue.
