

IL Route 71 to Caton Farm Rd.

Public Information Meeting #2 March 14, 2013 - Meadowhawk Lodge, Yorkville

The second public information meeting for the Illinois Route 47 Study was held on March 14, 2013 at the Meadowhawk Lodge in the Hoover Forest Preserve in Yorkville. The meeting was an open house format and featured exhibit boards project aerials for review. Attendees had the opportunity to provide comments and meet with IDOT and study team representatives on a one-on-one basis. The meeting was attended by **33 people**, and 3 **comments** were received.

Comments

- 1. Asked about the inclusion of a right turn lane at Conservation Drive.
- 2. Commended IDOT for work on the project. Requested notification for future meetings.
- 3. Encouraged that funds be spent instead on the north end of Rt. 47. Majority of residents go north, and traffic patterns would indicate this is the priority today.
