Public Meeting # 1 February 17, 2011 - Yorkville Public Library

The first public meeting for the Illinois Route 47 Study was held on February 17, 2011 at the Yorkville Public Library. The meeting was an open house format and featured exhibit boards for review. Attendees had the opportunity to provide comments and meet with IDOT and study team representatives on a one-on-one basis. The meeting was attended by 10 project study team members and 39 stakeholders, and 6 comments were received.

Public Meeting # 1 February 17, 2011 - Yorkville Public Library

The formal comment period ended March 4, 2011. A total of 6 comments were received, summarized as follows:

Comments

- 1. Thought it was extremely important (for Yorkville's future) to widen IL 47 and IL 71.
- 2. Supported a 4-lane plus median cross section on the southern portion of the project and a 5lane cross section to the north. Also, supported controlling access points and consolidating entrances to increase mobility.
- 3. Favored the project but was concerned about the traffic flow and drainage on Ament Road (west of IL 47).
- 4. Asked if their right turn lane (to their business) would be replaced.
- 5. Asked a question about the nearby IL 71 project. Also stated that subdivision developments should be connected so all traffic does not have to drive on IL 47.
- 6. Requested access to their nearby parcel of land.

Stakeholders will have the opportunity to provide additional comments throughout the study process.
