




Study Intent








Existing Urban Typical Sections











Existing Suburban/Industrial Typical Sections






PAYSON AVENUE TO LOCK AND DAM ROAD


Public Meeting Comments

Improvements necessary for economic development

Opposed to a 4-lane roadway

4 lanes needed to manage current traffic volumes

- ROW concerns, loss of business property
- Decouple 3rd and 4th Streets
- Rebuild Maine St from 3rd St to the river
- Notification of Levee protection
- Cost is too high
- Road just needs to be repaved
- Improve safety
- Install lighting and speed cameras
- Reduce speed limit
- Improve conditions for pedestrians and cyclists
- Consider moving and elevating road to the west near Marblehead to limit flooding
- Consider center turn lane and dedicated turning lanes



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Purpose and Need

The **Purpose** for this PEL is to determine potential projects that would

- Improve deficient roadway and intersection geometry,
- Improve corridor safety,
- Improve mobility, and
- Enhance pedestrian and bicycle access where warranted.


The **Need** is to address the issues of





Urban - Broadway to Payson Avenue




Suburban - Payson Avenue to 12th Street
