Come one, come all! The Illinois Department of Transportation is hosting an open-house public meeting to discuss a study of two miles of Illinois 3 from East St. Louis to Sauget, and you are invited.

The study is being conducted to evaluate and recommend solutions to improve the roadway's efficiency and regional mobility in the Metro East area. Proposed updates include:

- Increasing highway capacity and safety
- Improving access and traffic distribution to Mississippi River crossings
- Completing Illinois Route 3 between Waterloo and Alton
- Improving access to existing, planned, and potential riverfront development

Attendees may arrive anytime between 3 and 6 p.m. at the East St. Louis Community College Center.

The first Relocated Illinois 3 public meeting will:

- + Introduce study information
- + Review existing conditions
- + Describe steps for developing solutions and present initial improvement strategies
- + Seek public input
- + Share information about public involvement opportunities

The meeting will also include a video presentation, exhibits and the opportunity for the public to ask questions and provide feedback directly to the project study team.
