Purpose of the Virtual Meeting

The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the project's proposed improvements and receive questions or comments. Exhibits and aerial maps are included in the presentation and available for review. What is the I-64 Project?

IDOT, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is conducting pre-liminary engineering studies of I-64 from Green Mount Road to Illinois 158 in St. Clair County, Illinois. The studies include evaluating I-64 and the interchange at Green Mount Road for capacity and mobility improvements to reduce delays and improve safety. The preliminary engineering and environmental studies are known as the Phase I study. During this phase, proposed geometry, environmental concerns, and right-of-way requirements are defined. A project report will be developed that documents this process.

Overview & Scope

I-64 is proposed to be expanded from 4-lanes to 6-lanes from the existing 6-lane section, which ends west of Green Mount Road to the existing 6-lane section that begins west of Illinois 158. Interchange improvements at Green Mount Road are included in the project scope. This will include widening the existing entrance and exit ramps and Green Mount Road to provide additional turn lanes. These improvements to I-64 and the Green Mount Road interchange will improve the capacity and operations of the interstate.

Why is this project needed?

The need to make improvements within this section of I-64 is due to several factors, including heavy traffic volumes that exceed roadway capacity, fewer lanes than east and west of project, excessive delays at the Green Mount Road interchange and the interstate doesn't meet all current design policies.

Funding Status

All engineering and construction is currently included in the Department's Fiscal Year 2022-2027 Proposed Highway Improvement Program.
