- Please support extension of Silver Creek Trail and include trail in widening work.

- Please include a safe intersection at Bauer Road.
- Please embrace commercial development along US Route 40 in City as part of the City's land use plan.
- Please plan for the extension of SRA Bradley R. Smith Drive to US Route 40.
- Extension of Silver Creek Trail is a major improvement that provides future access to St. Jacob and Highland and opens important corridors in Troy and should be highly valued in this process.
