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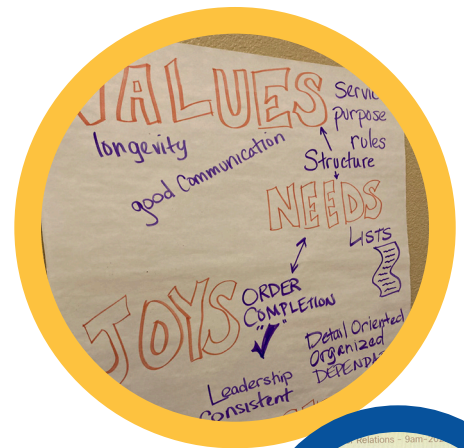

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ONLINE ENROLLMENT

The courses listed on the following pages constitute the Technology Transfer Training Program and are scheduled to be presented on the dates and locations indicated. These classes are all tuition-free, unless otherwise noted. Travel, meals and lodging expenses are always the responsibility of the student.

ENROLLMENT

We invite your agency to enroll students in the classes you desire by completing our online [enrollment form](#).

It is important that you enroll early. Some classes fill up quickly, and we may not be able to schedule additional classes.

In cases of excess enrollment, some attendance restrictions will be imposed. In cases of insufficient enrollment, classes may be cancelled. Enrollment in a class will be handled accordingly.

The contact person listed on the online enrollment form will receive an email approximately 24-48 hours prior to the class confirming their registration and providing the classroom/location information. If the class fills up, the applicant will be notified by email that they have been placed on a waiting list and will be contacted if there are cancellations.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If a student is unable to attend, it is the agency's responsibility to cancel at least 24 hours prior to the class. Frequent no shows may result in your agency receiving lower priority in future enrollments.

CONSULTANT POLICY

Enrollment for consultants will be allowed in all Technology Transfer training classes except for local agency only classes. Due to the popularity of our classes, we must limit each consulting firm to a maximum of four attendees per class.

CERTIFICATES

A certificate of completion will be awarded to students who successfully complete the final examination for the class. In classes where final exams are not given, a certificate of attendance will be awarded. The majority of T2 classes meet the requirements for Professional Development Hours. The number of PDHs given per class can be found with the course description; however, it is the student's responsibility to ensure that the course meets the continuing education requirements of their license.

NOTE: CHANGES TO SCHEDULING OF FLAGGER TRAININGS

IDOT recommends retraining flaggers every three years. Flaggers who have not been trained in the last three years should be scheduled for training or use the online version of Flagger Safety training.

Flagger training sessions are scheduled regionally throughout the state. Additional trainings may be added and announced monthly from the T2 email subscription service. However, our capacity to add classes is limited. If your agency has a training room that is computer/projector accessible, will seat at least 50 participants and is open to employees from other agencies, please email Stephanie Stoverink or Barry Kent to be considered for a class onsite at your location.

The U.S. Department of Labor and the Illinois Department of Labor have not specifically defined flagging as a hazardous job. However, the Illinois Department of Transportation recognizes that certain hazards and risks come with the job. Therefore, registration for and participation in flagger training classes and activities are limited to participants aged 18 and up.

2024 FALL TRAINING COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Flagger Training

Overview: This class provides training to local agency personnel for their day labor and maintenance activities. It meets requirements established by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration.

Prerequisites: This course is available to local agency highway personnel holding a valid driver's license or an Illinois identification card from the Secretary of State.

Topics Covered: Traffic control devices, the flagger's role in work zone safety, Illinois laws and responsibilities, and flagging procedures.

Introduction to Sewer Cleaning

Overview: This training includes a morning classroom session and an afternoon hands-on equipment demonstration in the field.

Topics Covered: Sewer cleaning, production and cost reduction, pneumatic plugs, use and maintenance of high-pressure sewer hose, nozzles, general sewer cleaning safety, vacuum system, jetter hose repair and general nozzle uses.

Lessons From Disaster

Overview: Students will learn to identify the critical decisions and events that preceded three past disasters. By understanding more about these disasters, highway engineers and technicians are more likely to identify similar mistakes in their own work, which may prevent future

accidents.

Topics Covered: The class will share insights on 3 disaster case studies: Fox River Grove Bus-Train Crash (IL, 1995), Schoharie Creek Bridge Collapse (NY, 1987) and the Space Shuttle Challenger disaster (FL, 1986).

Snow and Ice Control Training

Overview: The course provides training to local agency personnel for their winter snow and ice operations.

Topics Covered: Planning for snow and ice operations, weather information sources, equipment, snow and ice chemicals, chloride and the environment, level of service, and post-storm activities.

How to Read Plans for Non-Engineers

Overview: This course covers the basics of plan reading. Participants will learn to how to identify and use plans for the purpose of construction, estimating or maintenance of roadway with the use of record drawings. Participants will take away skills to recognize and identify typical sections, pay items, and profiles on plan sheets, use As-builts plans to identify materials and standards to maintain construction projects after final construction.

Open-Source AI-Artificial Intelligence

Overview: This webinar describes successes and challenges of motivating public and nonprofit workers to use open-source software in their workplaces and homes. Based on Dr. Funderburg's experience teaching two new courses on AI to Public Management and Policy students at the University of Illinois Springfield, participants will learn how to take advantage of recent technological advances in AI and understand how the tools and algorithms work.

Overview: With workers slowing to return to using public transit since the pandemic, this course discusses large budget shortfalls for transit agencies across the nation. Join Dr. Richard Funderburg in this on-demand webinar for transit in Greater Chicago. He shares recent findings from state-of-the-art research using cell phone tracing data to gauge travel demand.

It is well-suited for public works departments and first responders, providing lessons on how to respond in an emergency when dealing with fallen power lines/wires, whether they're on the road or if maintenance equipment accidentally encounters them overhead.

IDOT Phase 1 Course

Overview: To develop a better understanding of the Illinois Department of Transportation's Phase 1 process.

Topics Covered: Developing a transportation project's purpose and need, roles and responsibilities of local, state, and federal agencies, environmental studies conducted through the Environmental Survey Request process, analyzing and incorporating necessary engineering and environmental findings, and differences among Categorical Exclusions (CE), Environmental Assessments (EA), and Environmental Impact Statements (EIS).

Training covers a review of the differences in State jurisdiction and regulations and the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements that are implemented at the local level through the community's floodplain development ordinances.
