**Step two:** Toddlers (age 2+) face the front in seats with a harness and top tether until they reach their car seat's height or weight limit.

Step three: Bigger kids use booster seats until close to 4'9". By law in Illinois, kids must ride in a booster seat until at least age 8. Remember, children under age 13 should ride in the back seat.

Step four: Everyone buckles up in every seating position, for life!
