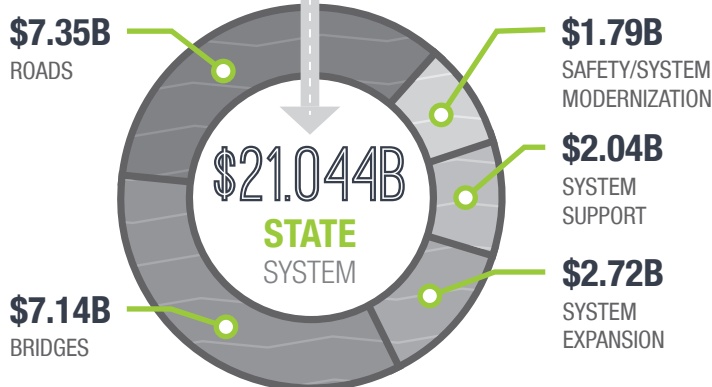

### MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

#### CHAMPAIGN

- **U.S. 150:** \$15.6 million for resurfacing and widening 1.6 miles and other improvements from I-74 interchange to Illinois 10 in Champaign.
- **I-72:** \$13.5 million for bridge replacement over I-57 west of Champaign.
- **U.S. 45:** \$10.6 million for resurfacing 3 miles from Springfield Avenue in Champaign to Curtis Road in Savoy.

#### DEWITT

- **U.S. 51:** \$13 million for resurfacing 10.9 miles from the McLean County line to the Macon County line.

#### DOUGLAS & CHAMPAIGN

- **I-57:** \$64.1 million for resurfacing on 24.3 miles from the Coles County line to Sadorus Road.

#### DOUGLAS & EDGAR

- **Illinois 133:** \$20.7 million for resurfacing 26.4 miles from I-57 in Arcola to Illinois 16 in Paris.

#### EDGAR

- **U.S. 150/Illinois 1:** \$17.5 million for resurfacing 6.5 miles, ADA improvements and guardrail work from Moss Road north of Paris to Gibson Drive south of Paris.

#### MCLEAN

- **Illinois 9/U.S. 150/U.S. 51 Business:** \$58.6 million for reconstruction of 1.3 miles, resurfacing on 6.2 miles, ADA improvements, curb and gutter, traffic signal replacement and bridge deck repairs from Martin Luther King Drive to Carnahan Drive.
- **I-74:** \$21 million for resurfacing 10 miles, including ramps, from Township Road 90 south of Carlock to I-55 north of Normal.
- **U.S. 51 Business:** \$25.5 million for resurfacing and widening of 5.1 miles, ADA improvements and traffic signal modernization from Gregory Street/Bowles Street in Normal to Olive Street in Bloomington.

#### VERMILION

- **I-74:** \$30 million for resurfacing on 7.2 miles, ramp repairs, bridge replacements, bridge deck overlay and other improvements from US 150/Illinois 1 to the Indiana state line.
