



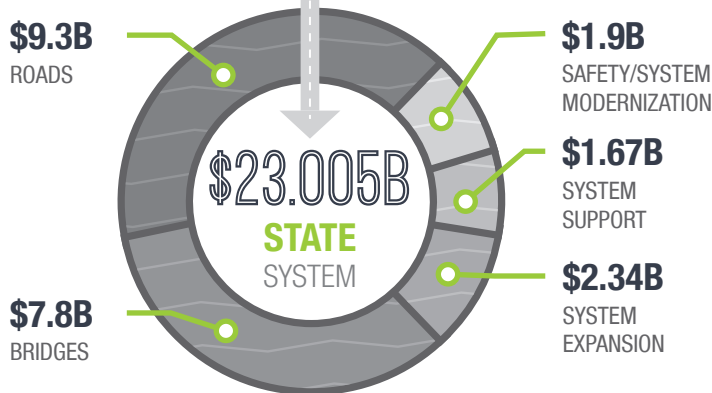

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

COOK

- **I-55 at Illinois 50:** \$172.9 million for bridge replacement and pedestrian and bicycle improvements at Illinois 50. Bridge deck overlays and bridge joint replacements/repairs on several bridges from Illinois 50 to Chinatown feeder ramps in Cook County.
- **I-55:** \$38 million for bridge replacement and pedestrian and bicycle improvements at Illinois 43 in Forest View.
- **I-80 (Eastbound):** \$27.5 million for bridge replacement at I-294 in Hazel Crest.
- **I-90/94:** \$49.4 million for bridge deck overlays, bridge joint replacements and repairs, bridge approach roadwork, patching and other improvements from I-94 to Hubbard Street in Chicago.
- **I-90/94 from Ohio Street to 31st Street:** Engineering for design, location and environmental studies at an estimated total cost of \$12 million.
- **I-90 from Bessie Coleman Drive to I-90 (Kennedy Expressway):** \$625.7 million for reconstruction and construction of auxiliary lanes, additional ramps, and improving safety and access to O'Hare International Airport in Chicago and Rosemont.
- **I-290 Corridor:** \$989.6 million for bridge replacement and rehabilitation from Mannheim Road to Racine Avenue.
- **U.S. 12/20/45 (95th Street):** \$80.7 million for several bridge replacements, intersection reconstruction and additional improvements at Stony Island Avenue in Chicago.
- **U.S. 20:** \$130.6 million for construction of a new interchange, reconstruction, retaining walls and bridge replacement at Shales Parkway in Elgin.
- **Illinois 43:** \$91.3 million for a railroad grade separation at the BRC railroad in Bedford Park.
- **Illinois 43:** \$14.6 million for bridge superstructure rehabilitation, bridge repair, and pedestrian and bicycle improvements at Sanitary and Ship Canal in Forest View.
- **Illinois 53:** \$143.1 million for 12 new bridge decks, three bridge superstructure replacements, rehabilitation of the structure carrying Euclid Avenue over Illinois 53, bridge painting, resurfacing on 5 miles, and pedestrian and bicycle improvements from south of U.S. 12 to Illinois 62.
- **Ida B. Wells Drive:** \$25.4 million for bridge superstructure replacement, superstructure rehabilitation and new bridge deck at the Old Post Office in Chicago.
- **Pershing Road:** \$53.8 million for bridge replacement and pedestrian and bicycle improvements at Racine Avenue and at CN Railroad in Chicago.
- **Willow Road:** \$22 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 1 mile, intersection improvement, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, and additional improvements from east of the Des Plaines River to Waterview Drive/Protection Parkway in Glenview and Prospect Heights.

DUPAGE

- **Illinois 38:** \$16.2 million for resurfacing on 1 mile, widening of existing pavement, drainage and patching from Winfield Road to County Farm Road.

KANE

- **Illinois 47/U.S. 30:** \$96.8 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 4.3 miles, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, bridge replacements, culvert replacements and railroad relocation from Cross Street to Galena Road in Sugar Grove and Yorkville.

LAKE

- **U.S. 41:** \$89.4 million for interchange reconstruction, construction of auxiliary lanes, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, bridge replacement, storm sewer, drainage and grading at Illinois 176 in Lake Bluff and North Chicago.
- **U.S. 45:** \$37 million for construction of additional lanes, reconstruction of 2 miles, and pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Illinois 132 to Washington Street.
- **Illinois 120:** \$27.7 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for nearly 1 mile as well as pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Ashford Lane to U.S. 45 in Grayslake.
- **Illinois 131:** \$87.5 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 2.5 miles as well as pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Wadsworth Road to Sunset Avenue in Beach Park.

MCHENRY

- **Illinois 31:** \$115 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 6.3 miles, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, culvert replacements, drainage improvements, traffic signal modernization and ADA improvements from Illinois 120 to Illinois 176 in McHenry, Prairie Grove and Crystal Lake.

WILL

- **I-55:** \$159 million for interchange reconstruction and bridge replacement at Lorenzo Road and at Illinois 129; also auxiliary lanes and resurfacing from Illinois 129 to Lorenzo Road and reconstruction of the frontage roads between Kavanaugh and Lorenzo roads.
- **I-55:** \$204.4 million for bridge replacements and construction of interchanges at Airport Road/Lockport Road and at Illinois 126 in Romeoville.
- **I-57:** \$192 million for new interchange and railroad crossing construction at Eagle Lake Road.
- **I-80 from Ridge Road to U.S. 30:** \$779.7 million for multiple bridge replacements, including aging, obsolete structures over the Des Plaines River. Capacity enhancements include auxiliary lanes and shoulders in Joliet, New Lenox and Minooka.
- **U.S. 52:** \$96.4 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, bridge widening, turning lanes, culvert extension and bridge repairs from River Road to Houbolt Road in Shorewood and Joliet.
- **Illinois 53/U.S. 52:** \$62.5 million for intersection improvements as well as pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Patterson Road to Arsenal Road in Joliet, Elwood and Wilmington.
