
MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

GRUNDY

 I-80: \$112.6 million for reconstruction of 6.5 miles, preliminary engineering, utility adjustments and other improvements from east of the Seneca interchange to west of Illinois 47.

IROQUOIS

- I-57: \$29.2 million for bridge deck overlays, bridge joint replacement/repairs, culvert repairs, bridge superstructure replacements and new bridge decks on various structures from 1.2 miles south of Sugar Creek to 1.3 miles north of Prairie Creek.
- **I-57:** \$23 million for resurfacing 7.9 miles from Ford County line to 0.7 mile south of the Buckley interchange.



KANKAKEE

• I-57/Illinois 17 Interchange: \$105 million for a bridge replacement, interchange reconstruction, reconstruction of 2.2 miles, railroad separation replacement and other improvements at the interchange, from south of Waldron Road to north of Illinois 17 and on Illinois 17 from North Fairmont Avenue to Eastgate Parkway.

KENDALL

- **Illinois 47:** \$60.5 million for reconstruction and additional lanes of 2.3 miles, railroad separation replacement, bridge replacement and other improvements between Galena and Kennedy roads in Yorkville.
- **Illinois 47:** \$46 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 4.2 miles, as well as other improvements, from Illinois 71 to Caton Farm Road.
- Illinois 126: \$12 million for resurfacing of 9.2 miles, preliminary engineering, utility adjustments and other improvements from Illinois 71 to Will County line.

LASALLE

- I-39/U.S. 51: \$53 million for reconstruction of 2.8 miles from Marshall County line to 0.3 mile north of Norfolk Southern railroad and resurfacing of 9.5 miles from 0.3 mile north of NS railroad to 0.5 mile south of Illinois 351.
- Illinois 23 and Illinois 23B/Illinois 71A: \$26 million for a new bridge deck at the Illinois River, bridge replacement, utility adjustments and other improvements in Ottawa.
