MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

FULTON, KNOX AND MCDONOUGH

• Illinois 41: \$29.3 million for resurfacing of 11.7 miles and utility adjustments from Illinois 116 to Illinois 9.

FULTON AND PEORIA

 U.S. 24/Illinois 9: \$137.6 million for expansion to four lanes on 8.6 miles and bridge replacements from Banner to Kingston Mines.

HENDERSON

 U.S. 34: \$174.5 million for new construction of 8.7 miles from west of Carman Road to Township Road 111.

MARSHALL

 Illinois 18: \$127.5 million for a bridge replacement at the Illinois River in Henry.

MAHOHALL

PEORIA

- Illinois 29: \$64.5 million for reconstruction of 2.6 miles and addition of a bi-directional left turn lane from Gardner Lane to north of Lorentz Avenue in Peoria.
- Illinois 116: \$44.7 million for reconstruction of 3.1 miles from Washington Street to Griswold Street in Peoria.
- Adams Street: \$57 million for bridge replacements, railroad flagger and other improvements over BNSF and UP railroads at the western city limits of Peoria.

TAZEWELL AND PEORIA

• **U.S. 150 (Westbound):** \$76 million for a new bridge deck, bridge superstructure rehabilitation, bridge painting and bridge repair over Illinois 29 and the Illinois River.

WARREN

• **U.S. 34:** \$64 million for additional lanes of 4.6 miles and utility adjustments from Township Road 190 east of Biggsville to 20th Street south of Kirkwood.

WOODFORD

• I-74: \$24.5 million for a bridge replacement at the Mackinaw River.
