MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

CHAMPAIGN

• **U.S. 150:** \$18.1 million for resurfacing and widening 1.6 miles and other improvements from I-74 interchange to Illinois 10 in Champaign.

DEWITT


• U.S. 51: \$25 million for reconstruction of 3 miles from McLean County line to Autumn Road.

DOUGLAS

• Illinois 133: \$16.9 million for resurfacing 11.9 miles, culvert replacements, utility adjustments, new shoulders, safety improvements and culvert extension from 0.5 mile east of I-57 to Coles County line.

DOUGLAS AND CHAMPAIGN

 I-57: \$30 million for resurfacing on 12.1 miles and bridge deck overlays from the Coles County line to Sadorus Road.



EDGAR

• **U.S. 150/Illinois 1:** \$21 million for resurfacing 16.7 miles (including cold milling on 6.5 miles), guardrail, ADA improvements and land acquisition from U.S. 36 to south of Gibson Drive south of Paris.

MCLEAN

- I-74: \$21 million for resurfacing 10.8 miles, including ramps, from Township Road 90 south of Carlock to I-55 north of Normal
- **U.S. 51 Business:** \$60 million for resurfacing and widening 2.7 miles, resurfacing 2.8 miles, ADA improvements and traffic signal modernization from Gregory Street/Bowles Street in Normal to Woodrig Road in Bloomington.
- **Illinois 9:** \$22 million for resurfacing 2 miles, ADA improvements, curb and gutter, and traffic signal replacement from Towanda Service Road to Carnahan Drive east of Bloomington.

VERMILION

• I-74: \$30.5 million for resurfacing 7.2 miles, including underdrains and ramp repair, bridge removal/demolition and bridge widening from U.S. 150/Illinois 1 at Tilton to Indiana State line and at Perrysville Road and Bowman Avenue overheads in Danville.
