



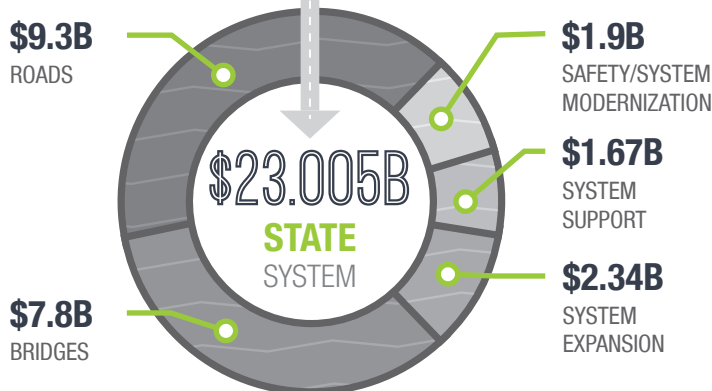

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

ADAMS

- Quincy Memorial Bridge:** \$156 million for bridge replacement at Mississippi River in Quincy. Illinois is the lead agency; Missouri and Illinois will share these costs equally.
- Illinois 104:** \$13.9 million for resurfacing 4.2 miles, intersection reconstruction, traffic signal replacement, traffic signal modernization and ADA improvements from west of 12th Street to I-172 in Quincy.

CHRISTIAN

- Illinois 29:** \$14.6 million for resurfacing 1 mile, reconstruction of 1 mile, ADA improvements, traffic signal replacement and traffic signal modernization from Illinois 104 to McAdam Drive in Taylorville.

HANCOCK

- U.S. 136/South Second Street:** \$17.9 million for vertical and horizontal realignment on 0.8 mile, bridge replacement, railroad crossing improvement and other improvements from Mississippi River to Main Street in Hamilton.

LOGAN

- I-55:** \$42.8 million for resurfacing 8.5 miles, shoulder reconstruction, underdrain work, bridge deck repairs, bridge deck overlay and bridge joint replacement/repair from I-55 northwest of Lincoln to 2 miles south of U.S. 136.

MACOUPIN

- Illinois 16:** \$25.4 million for resurfacing 10.3 miles, new shoulders, bridge replacement, new culvert, culvert replacement, culvert extension, culvert removal and ADA improvements from Jersey County line to Illinois 159 and Illinois 111/267.

PIKE

- I-72:** \$135.4 million for resurfacing on 28.4 miles, shoulder reconstruction, underdrain work, bridge deck repairs, bridge joint replacement/repair and bridge deck overlay from Illinois 96 to U.S. 54/Illinois 107.

SANGAMON

- I-55:** \$125 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 7.8 miles, including ramp repair, from Illinois 54/Sangamon Avenue in Springfield to 2.7 miles south of Illinois 123 in Williamsville.
- I-55 Business/6th Street/5th Street:** \$22.5 million for reconstruction of 5.2 miles, intersection reconstruction, turning lanes, sidewalks, bikeway and utility adjustments from Stevenson Drive to Stanford Avenue in Springfield.
- Illinois 97/125:** \$39.2 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 2.2 miles, bridge replacement, intersection reconstruction, a new bridge and utility adjustments from Illinois 97/125 junction to Old Covered Bridge Lane.
- MacArthur Boulevard:** \$21 million for reconstruction of 1.5 miles, traffic signal replacement, ADA improvements and other improvements from Wabash/Stanford Avenue to South Grand Avenue in Springfield.
