MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

COLES

• I-57: \$74.6 million for reconstruction of 10.9 miles from Illinois 16 to Douglas County line.

CLARK

- U.S. 40: \$21.9 million for resurfacing 26.6 miles, traffic signal modernization, new shoulders and safety improvements from Illinois 49 to Indiana state line.
- Illinois 1: \$16.5 million for resurfacing 10.3 miles, ADA improvements, bridge deck overlay, bridge repairs, traffic signal modernization and pedestrian signals from Edgar County line to Grand Turn Road.

CLAY AND EFFINGHAM

 U.S. 45: \$22.9 million for resurfacing 11.2 miles, vertical and horizontal realignment, bridge deck repairs and a retaining wall from Illinois 37 to Bible Grove Road.

CUMBERLAND

• I-57: \$31.8 million to replace four bridges and additional improvements over Eastern Illinois Railroad south of Neoga interchange and U.S. 45 at Neoga interchange.

CUMBERLAND AND SHELBY

I-57: \$26.1 million for resurfacing 8.9 miles from Effingham County line to U.S. 45 at Neoga.

EFFINGHAM

• U.S. 40/U.S. 45/Illinois 33/Fayette Avenue: \$26.5 million for reconstruction and additional lanes of 1.2 miles, ADA improvements, curb and gutter, and storm sewer from Banker Street to Salt Creek in Effingham.

FAYETTE

I-70: \$21 million for resurfacing 11.6 miles, including ramp repair, from Bond County line to Kaskaskia River east of Vandalia.

LAWRENCE

U.S. 50: \$50.6 million for bridge replacements and median crossovers from Beaver Pond Ditch to Sun and Sand Drive.

MACON

- I-72/U.S. 51: \$15.1 million for a bridge replacement over Illinois 121 and Illinois Central Railroad northwest of Decatur.
- I-72/U.S. 36/U.S. 51: \$31.6 million for resurfacing 10.2 miles and ramp repairs from west of U.S. 51 west of Decatur to west of U.S. 51 in Forsyth.
- Old U.S. 51 Business: \$14.4 million for resurfacing of 4.3 miles and ADA improvements from Illinois 121 to U.S. 36 in Decatur.

MOULTRIE

• Illinois 121: \$5.8 million for resurfacing of 2.6 miles, ADA improvements, bridge deck overlay, bridge deck repairs, traffic signal modernization and pedestrian signals from Illinois 32 to Eastlawn Drive in Sullivan.
