MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

ALEXANDER

- I-57: \$55 million for bridge painting and bridge deck overlay for the Mississippi River Bridge in Cairo. Illinois is leading the project, with Missouri sharing equally in the cost.
- U.S. 51/60/62: \$187.1 million for bridge replacement at the Ohio River 1 mile south of Cairo. Kentucky is leading the project; these costs represent Illinois' share.

FRANKLIN

 Illinois 154: \$20.3 million for bridge replacement and a bikeway from Fitzgerrell Park Drive to Larry Foster Parkway and resurfacing on 2.3 miles from Fitzgerrell Park Drive at Rend Lake to Illinois 37.

FRANKLIN AND JEFFERSON

- I-57: \$110 million for additional lanes for 10.2 miles and bridge replacements along a critical freight corridor from 2.5 miles south of Illinois 154 to the I-64 South Tri-Level interchange in Mount Vernon.
- Illinois 37: \$42.2 million for resurfacing 13.8 miles, new shoulders, bikeway and a bridge replacement from Campground Road in Bonnie to Illinois 14 in Benton.



• **I-57/I-64:** \$50.5 million for interchange reconstruction and bridge replacement at the Illinois 15 interchange in Mount Vernon.

MASSAC

• **Ohio River Bridge (I-24):** \$44.2 million for bridge painting and bridge deck overlay at Metropolis. Illinois is leading the project, with Kentucky sharing equally in the cost.

PERRY

• Illinois 152: \$13.5 million for resurfacing 6.8 miles and new shoulders from Illinois 127 to U.S. 51.

IIMION

• Illinois 146: \$11.5 million for reconstruction of 1.4 miles and resurfacing of 1.2 miles from Illinois 127 in Jonesboro to U.S. 51.

WILLIAMSON

- 1-57: \$45 million for additional lanes for 7.9 miles from I-24 to south of Old Illinois 13 in Marion.
- Illinois 13: \$46 million for additional lanes for 2 miles and bridge replacements from Spillway Road to Shawnee Trail.
