




PREFACE

The Directory of Lake and River Terminals in Illinois - 1988 has been prepared by the Ports Management Section, Division of Water Resources, Illinois Department of Transportation, in keeping with a designated responsibility to "... undertake port and waterway development planning and studies of port and waterway development problems."

Waterway terminals are the facilities which allow Illinois' shippers to utilize safe, fuel-efficient and low-cost water transportation. This Directory provides general information about each active waterway terminal in the state, including its location and contact person, the types of commodities handled, its handling and storage capabilities, and its intermodal access.



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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

Purpose of the Directory

The purpose of this Directory is to assist the State in port and waterway planning, and to assist current and potential shippers by publishing an inventory of the active waterway terminal facilities in Illinois.

The State of Illinois has a total of 295 active waterway terminals with 345 docks, located on the Illinois Waterway, the Mississippi, Ohio and Kaskaskia Rivers, and Lake Michigan.

Terminal Survey Method

The Department conducted a mail survey to obtain the desired information for this Directory. Participation in the survey was voluntary. Those firms which did not respond to the initial mailed survey or a follow-up mailed survey were contacted by telephone. For firms which chose to not respond to the survey, data was compiled from existing information..

Definition of Terms

A review of several of the terms used in this Directory may be useful to the reader.

Bank — The left or right bank of the river looking downstream.

Barge Loading Rates -- Average hourly rates for the major commodities loaded at the terminal.

Barge Unloading Rates -- Average hourly rates for the major commodities unloaded at the terminal.

Contact Person -- The terminal manager or other company official who should be contacted by a potential shipper concerning use of the terminal.

Draft -- The distance from the water line to the lowest point of the vessel that is under water, measured when the vessel is completely stopped. Ocean-going ships and lake boats on the Calumet River and Lake Calumet may have a maximum draft of 26'9", lake boats at Waukegan Harbor may have a draft of 18', and barges and towboats on the inland waterway system may have a draft of 9'.

Lock — A structure in a waterway with gates at each end, used in raising and lowering vessels from one water level to another. A typical lock is 600' or 1,200' long and 110' wide. Locks are usually constructed with a dam that holds back the water to create a navigable waterway.

Navigable Waterway — A canal, channel, harbor or river capable of transit by commercial vessels. For Illinois, this includes Calumet Harbor, Calumet River, Cal-Sag Channel, Chicago Harbor, Chicago River, Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal, Des Plaines River, Illinois River, Kaskaskia River, Lake Calumet, Little Calumet River, Mississippi River, Ohio River, and Waukegan Harbor.

Private Terminal — A terminal that is not generally available for use by other shippers.

Public Terminal — A terminal that is generally available for use by other shippers.

River Mile — The distance in statute miles from a recognized reference point. The Calumet River, Cal-Sag Channel, Chicago River, Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal, Des Plaines River, Illinois River, Lake Calumet; and Little Calumet River are measured from the junction of the Illinois River with the Mississippi River at Grafton, Illinois. The Kaskaskia River is measured from the junction with the Mississippi River. The Mississippi River is measured from the junction with the Ohio River at Cairo, Illinois, and the Ohio River is measured from the junction with the Allegheny and Monongahela Rivers at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Storage Capacity -- Instantaneous storage capacity for the commodity handled at the terminal.

Terminal -- A cargo handling facility which includes the dock, transfer equipment, storage area, land access, and other related facilities. One terminal may have one or more docks.

Ton -- A short ton of 2,000 pounds.

CHAPTER II

ILLINOIS NAVIGATION SYSTEM

The Navigation System Serving Illinois

The State of Illinois has 295 active waterway terminals and 1,119 miles of commercially navigable waterways, providing Illinois with among the largest commercial navigation systems of all the inland states. In addition, the State borders on 60 miles of navigable Lake Michigan waters, providing access to the Atlantic Ocean via the Great Lakes/St. Lawrence Seaway System.

Waterways in Illinois




FIGURE 1: NAVIGABLE WATERWAYS IN ILLINOIS




FIGURE 2: NAVIGABLE WATERWAYS IN THE CHICAGO AREA

Following is a discussion of the main features of each of the waterways that serve the state. Figure 1 identifies the navigable waterways in Illinois, and Figure 2 identifies the navigable waterways in the Chicago area. Table 1 indicates the miles of each navigable waterway in Illinois, Table 2 indicates the miles of navigable waterways in Illinois by vessel draft, and Table 3 identifies the navigation locks in Illinois.

Mississippi River. The Mississippi River forms the western border of the State of Illinois, a distance of 581 river miles from the Wisconsin state line south to the confluence with the Ohio River. Towboats and barges on the Mississippi River may have a draft of 9'. Bordering the State of Illinois, there are 14 lock locations from the Wisconsin state line south to Granite City (near St. Louis); the Mississippi River is lock-free from Granite City to New Orleans.

Illinois Waterway. The Illinois Waterway traverses the state from Lake Michigan west and then southwest to its junction with the Mississippi River at Grafton. Towboats and barges on the Illinois

Waterway system may have a draft of 9'. There are nine locks on the Illinois Waterway.

In Chicago, the inland waterway system begins at two points on Lake Michigan: one at the mouth of the Chicago River and one at the mouth of the Calumet River. From Lake Michigan, the Chicago River flows six miles to the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal, which flows for 31 miles to the Des Plaines River. From Lake Michigan, the Calumet River flows about 7 miles to Lake Calumet and the Little Calumet River. The Little Calumet River flows 6 miles to the Calumet-Sag Channel, which then flows 16 miles to the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal northeast of Lemont.

The Des Plaines River flows 18 river miles to its junction with the Kankakee River. The Illinois River begins at this point and flows 273 miles to its junction with the Mississippi River.

Ohio River. The Ohio River forms the southern border of the state, a distance of 134 river miles from the Indiana State Line west to the Mississippi River. Towboats and barges on the Ohio River may have a draft of 9'. Locks and dams have been constructed at three locations bordering Illinois.

Kaskaskia River. The commercially navigable portion of the Kaskaskia River extends a distance of 36 miles from its mouth on the Mississippi River to Fayetteville. Towboats and barges on the Kaskaskia River may have a draft of 9'. There is one lock on the Kaskaskia, less than a mile from the Mississippi River.

The Great Lakes/St. Lawrence Seaway System

The Great Lakes/St. Lawrence Seaway System extends a distance of 2,250 miles from the Atlantic Ocean to Chicago and 2,342 miles to Duluth, Minnesota. The System is comprised of 1,000 miles of tidewater from the Atlantic Ocean to Montreal on the St. Lawrence River, 190 miles of the locked section of the St. Lawrence River from Montreal to Lake Ontario, 160 miles across Lake Ontario, 26 miles of the locked Welland Canal between Lakes Ontario and

Erie, and 874 miles of Great Lakes and connecting channels to Chicago.

The Great Lakes. The Great Lakes navigation system consists of Lake Erie, Lake Huron, Lake Michigan, Lake Ontario, and Lake Superior. A set of five parallel locks are located at Sault Ste. Marie on the St. Mary's River, which connects Lake Superior to Lake Huron. Lakes Michigan and Huron are connected by the Straits of Mackinac. Lakes Huron and Erie are connected by the St. Clair River, Lake St. Clair, and the Detroit River. Lakes Erie and Ontario are connected by the Welland Canal.

The largest Soo lock, the Poe Lock, limits the size of vessels which operate over the St. Mary's River between Lakes Superior and Lake Huron to a maximum length of 1,100 feet, width of 105 feet and draft of 27 feet. Ocean-going ships and lake boats on the Calumet River and Lake Calumet may have a maximum draft of 26'9". Lake boats at Waukegan Harbor may have a draft of 18'.

The St. Lawrence Seaway. The St. Lawrence Seaway connects the Great Lakes with the Atlantic Ocean via the St. Lawrence River. There are seven locks on the Seaway; they limit the size of vessels which operate on the Seaway to a maximum length of 730 feet, width of 76 feet and draft of 27 feet.

There are eight lock locations on the Welland Canal, which provides a navigation bypass around the Niagara River and Niagara Falls between Lakes Erie and Ontario. Five sites have single locks and three sites have two parallel locks, for a total of 11 locks. The locks limit the size of vessels which transit the Welland Canal to a maximum length of 730 feet, width of 76 feet and draft of 27 feet.

Illinois' Annual Cargo Tonnage

The major commodities carried on Illinois' inland river system include grain, coal, chemicals, petroleum, and sand and gravel. The major commodities shipped to and from Illinois on the Great Lakes/St. Lawrence Seaway System include grain, iron and steel, coal and iron ore. The tonnage of Illinois' waterborne shipments are shown in Tables 4, 5 and 6.

Illinois has 202 private terminals which are not generally available for use by other shippers, and 93 privately or publicly

owned terminals which consider themselves to be public terminals normally available for use by other shippers.

Table 8 identifies the number of terminals which handle various commodities. The number of terminals by commodity handled exceeds the number of terminals in the State because some terminals handle more than one commodity at their facility.




FIGURE 3: NUMBER OF TERMINALS IN COUNTIES ON NAVIGABLE WATERWAYS

CHAPTER III

ILLINOIS PORT DISTRICTS

Purpose of Port Districts




Figure 4: Port Districts in Illinois

A port district is a public body created by an act of the Illinois General Assembly to engage in the planning, development, operation, and promotion of water ports. A port district is also directed by the General Assembly to engage in activities to attract industrial, commercial and recreational developments to enhance the economy of the port district's area. There are eleven port districts located on navigable waterways, and two inactive port districts located on the non-navigable Wabash River. These thirteen port districts are identified in Figure 4.

Duties and Powers of Port Districts

Port districts possess duties and powers which can be used to undertake port and related industrial development. The duties and powers listed below represent a composite of those cited in the individual acts, and all may not apply to individual port districts.

1. Issue permits for the construction of water facilities.
2. Acquire, own, construct, lease, operate and maintain port and terminal facilities.
3. Acquire and accept any property rights for the development of port and terminal facilities and water channels. The right of eminent domain may be exercised to acquire property.
4. Develop and maintain water and sewage systems.
5. Petition any federal, state or local government having jurisdiction over lands within the district for needed improvements to port and terminal facilities.
6. Lease district land for industrial, manufacturing, commercial or harbor purposes.
7. Issue general obligation bonds after approval by referendum, or issue revenue bonds without a referendum.

Illinois' port districts may be able to provide assistance to potential shippers seeking new or existing terminal facilities. Firms are urged to contact the port districts or the Illinois Department of Transportation for further information. The appropriate contact person and mailing address for each port district is listed in Table 9.
